

The Applicant has challenged transfer order dated 31.01.2022 whereby he is transferred from the post of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Khadki Division, Pune to Assistant Commissioner of Police, Establishment (Headquarter), Commissioner Office, Pune and Respondent No.2 is posted in his place.</p> <p>3. Perusal of record reveals that Applicant was posted as Assistant Commissioner of Police, Khadki Division, Pune by order dated 10.10.2020. As such, he has not completed normal tenure. There is no reference in impugned order dated 31.01.2022 about recommendation of PEB.</p> <p>4. It is on the above background, learned Advocate for the Applicant sought interim relief or protection till filing of reply.</p> <p>5. Learned P.O. opposed interim relief stating that there is internal shifting within Commissionerate and it does not amount to transfer in the eye of law.</p> <p>6. <i>Prima-facie</i>, the Applicant has been displaced from the post of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Khadki Division which was given to him by order dated 10.10.2020. There is no reference of PEB in order dated 31.01.2022. As such, <i>prima-facie</i>, the Applicant seems to have been transferred in contravention of provisions of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005.</p> <p>7. In view of above, the execution of order dated 31.01.2022 is stayed till filing of reply.</p> <p>8. Issue notices to Respondents returnable on 15.02.2022.</p> <p>9. 




