### <u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Heard Shri A. A. Gharte, learned Counsel and Ms S. P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that Applicant is 'NT-D' and has applied for 'Multi Cadre' posts pursuant to Advertisement No.045/2022 published by Respondent No.2- MPSC on 11.05.2022 for State Services Preliminary Examination-2022.
- 3. Learned Counsel states that Applicant has applied for the 'Multi Cadre' posts under the category of 'Mental Illness/ Multiple Disabilities' of Clause of 'd' and 'e' of Section 34 (1) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016'. Thereafter, Respondent No.2 published Advertisement No.99/2022 dated 11.11.2022 for Staff Services Mains Examination-2022 wherein he was declared as passed and after got selected in Interview conducted by Respondent No.2, Applicant's name was placed at Sr. No.1811 in the 'General Merit List' published by MPSC on 18.01.2024.
- 4. Learned Counsel further submits that General Merit List dated 18.01.2024 also consists names of other 6 candidates who are selected/listed above the Applicant under the category of 'Multiple Disability/Mental Illness' but they do not fall under the category of Multiple Disability under Clauses (a) and (d) of Section 34(1) of 'The Rights of

Persons with Disability Act, 2016' coupled with 'Deafness-Blindness'. Learned Counsel submits that in the said Advertisements total of 6 posts are earmarked for 'Mental Illness/ Multiple Disabilities' category of Clause 'd' and 'e' of Section 34 (1) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016'. He thereupon submits that if one of the candidates out of 6 is found not to be having proper documents or requisite Disability Certificate under Clause 'd' and 'e' of Section 34 (1) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016'; then Applicant is eligible for recommendation by MPSC under the category reserved for category of 'Mental Illness/ Multiple Disabilities'.

- 5. Learned Counsel points out 'Disability Certificate' of Shri Aditya Bamane who is at Sr. No.1795 in 'General Merit List' which is at 'Exb. I', (Page No.279. The said 'Disability Certificate' discloses 3 types of disabilities i.e. Muscular Dystrophy, Locomotor Disability and Low Vision of left eye. He submits that the candidate at Sr. No.1795 -Shri Aditya Bamane has no 'Mental Illness' as contemplated under Clause 'd' of Section 34 (1) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016' and if at all his disabilities are to be considered under Clause 'e' of Section 34 of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016'. of 'Disability Act 2016' i.e 'Mental Illness/ Multiple Disabilities' then it is necessary that such candidate who suffers from Blindness and Deafness and also other disability under Clause (a) to (d) can be selected under Clause (e) of Section 34(1) of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016'. In case of selected candidate at Sr. No.1795- Shri Aditya Bamane, he has 'Low Vision' but has no aliment of Deafness. Therefore, his case cannot falls under Clause 'e' of 'The Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016' to make him eligible under 'Multiple Disability'.
- 6. Learned Counsel points out Applicant's 'Disability Certificate' dated 10.11.2024 issued by Dr. Archana Gadkari, Central Hospital, Ulhasnagar which is at Exabit A, page 23 of O.A. In the said 'Disability Certificate', the Applicant's disability is mentioned as follows:-
  - '(i) He is a case of Mental Illness
  - (ii) The diagnosis in his case is OCD with Depression.
  - (iii) He has 45% Permanent Disability in relation to his Mental Illness.
- 7. Learned Counsel for the Applicant prays that Respondent MPSC should be directed to reverify the 'Disability Certificates' of selected / wait listed candidates in

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accordance with GR dated 29.05.2019 read with Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016.

8. Learned Counsel for Applicant then relied on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *AIRLONLINE 2019 SC 1847 (Mukul Kumar Tyagi V/s State of Uttar Pradesh)* on the point of impleadment of proper and necessary parties. He referred to 'Para 75' of the said judgment on the point of proper and necessary party impleadment which reads as under:-

"75. The present is a case where the writ petitioners had not raised any challenge to a particular qualification of any individual candidate rather their challenge was that without scrutiny large number of candidates, who were claiming qualification equivalent to CCC certificate have been included without there being any scrutiny and without they fulfil the qualification. The case of the writ petitioners was that the computer certificate issued by the private organisations and unregistered societies, who neither were recognised by the State Government or Central Government or by any statutory body could not issue any certificate. We may further notice that Division Bench also noticed the above argument of non-impleadment of all the selected candidates in the writ petition but Division Bench has not based its judgment on the above argument. When the inclusion in the select list of large number of candidates is on the basis of an arbitrary or illegal process, the aggrieved parties can complain and in such cases necessity of impleadment of each and every person cannot be insisted. Furthermore, when select list contained names of 2211 candidates, it becomes unnecessary to implead every candidate in view of the nature of the challenge, which was levelled in the writ petition. Moreover, few selected candidates were also impleaded in the writ petitions in representative capacity.

- 9. In case of Mukul Kumar Tyagi's case (cited supra) in 'Para 75' referred by learned Counsel, the Select List contained names of 2211 candidates so it was not possible to implead all them as party. But in present case, there are only 6 candidates under the category of 'Mental Illness/ Multiple Disabilities'. Hence, the case referred by learned Counsel is not applicable in present O.A.
- 10. In view of the facts mentioned above, we are of the opinion that if we allow application or any order is passed in favour of the Applicant, the candidates whose 'Disability Certificates' are challenged, they are required to be made as 'Party Respondents' in present O.A.
- 11. The MPSC is directed to furnish Names and Addressed of the candidates whose 'Disability Certificates' are challenged in present O.A.
- 12. Learned Counsel prays for leave to carry out 'Amendments' to the O.A.
- 13. 'Amendments' is to be carried out by adding proposed 'Party Respondents'.



- 14. The office objection, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 15. Issue notice before admission returnable on 06.02.2024.
- 16. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of M.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 17. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 18. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 19. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the <u>Original</u> / Miscellaneous Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the <u>Original</u> / Miscellaneous Application shall stand dismissed.

Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that on the basis of the 'Sports Certificate Verification', Applicant was recruited on the post of 'Staff Nurse' in the Government General Hospital, Sangali from 'SC Sports Quota' on 14.08.2014. Thereafter, Respondent No.1 published an Advertisement on 21.02.2019 for filling up vacancies in Group 'C' Cadre by Direct Service. One of the posts mentioned in Advertisement was 'Sister Tutor'. Being eligible, the Applicant applied for the said post on 15.03.2019 and subsequently selected for the post of 'Sister Tutor' from 'SC Sports Quota'.
- 3. Learned Counsel for Applicant further points out that Applicant has played the sport of 'Volleyball' at State level. However, his 'Sports Certificate' was reverified as per directions of Respondent No.2 and reverification report issued by Resodnent No.3 was received on 10.03.2023 thereby declaring the Applicant eligible for 5% sports person reservation for posts in Group 'C' and 'D'. Despite this, Respondent No.2 by order dated 12.01.2024 cancelling the appointment of Applicant on the post of 'Sister Tutor' which is under challenged where the Respondent No.2 has outrightly rejected his appointment to the post of 'Sister Tutor' from 'SC Sports Quota' on the ground that reverification report dated 10.03.2023 submitted by the Applicant was after the date of Advertisement published by Government of Maharashtra.

#### Tribunal's orders

- 4. The Applicant, therefore, challenges the impugned order dated 12.01.2024 issued by Resodnent No.2 and seeks directions against the Respondent No.2 to consider the candidature of Applicant for further selection process for the post of 'Sister Tutor' by declaring his Sports Certificate as 'Valid'.

- 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereupon states that 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri Chinchwad' by separate Order dated 25.01.2024 without waiting for 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' to approve the proposal submitted by him on 24.01.2024 transferred several other 'Inspectors' serving in various 'Police Stations' in place of Applicants working in 'Crime Branch' by implementing directions in 'D.G.P. Learned Counsel has submitted that during the pendency of R.A., Applicant No.1, Smt. S.R. Kore died in April, 2023 and thus now Applicant No.2, Mr. A.R. Kore is prosecuting this R.A.
- 3. Learned Counsel has submitted that in O.A. the prayer for payment of Gratuity with interest, Leave Encashment with interest, Family pension with arrears and interest was made and the same was allowed. Besides this, Applicant had also prayed for claimed for ex-gratia payment of Rs.50 lakhs which was rejected in order dated 23.12.2022. Applicant has received the amount of GIS, medical reimbursement, provident fund insurance and saving fund on 14.11.2022.
- 4. Learned Counsel has prayed for ex-gratia payment of Rs.50 lakhs in R.A. Learned Counsel has submitted that Mr. R.S. Kore working as Excise Inspector, B Division, Nagpur died on 06.09.2020. He supposed to visit liquor shops and verify whether the guidelines of COVID-19 issued by the State and Central Government are strictly followed or not. In relies on paragraph 3 in G.R. dated 29.05.2020. Learned Counsel has further pointed out that from pages 27 to 42 of the R.A. there are various orders issued by the Government from time to time.
- 5. At the request of learned P.O. adjourned to 02.02.2024 at 10.00 a.m.
