At the time of hearing of all those OAs this Tribunal by order dated 26.11.2020 found that it was necessary for the applicants to go before the appellate authority. In these OAs the issue was in respect of fraud and forgery in respect of sports certificate. However, as stated earlier there is an appellate authority available to the applicants. 
