

1. Heard Shri M.D. Lonkar, learned Advocate for Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned PO for Respondents.

2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that request of Applicant who is 48% afflicted by 'Polio' which is 'Benchmark Disability' has not been fairly considered by 'Revenue & Forest Department' while transferring him to post of 'Special Deputy Superintendent of Land Records and Enquiry Officer, Mira-Bhayandar, District Thane'.

3. Learned Advocate for Applicant emphasizes that there is only partial implementation of the provisions of 'Section 2(y)' and 'Section 20(2)' of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016' regarding 'Reasonable Accommodation' by 'Revenue & Forest Department'; as office of 'Special Deputy Superintendent of Land Records and Enquiry Officer, Mira-Bhayandar, District Thane' is located on 'Third Floor' of 'Office Building' which has no 'Lifts'. Hence, it would be equally inconvenient for Applicant who has 'Benchmark Disability', as it is even now when serving on post of 'Deputy Superintendent of Land Records' at 'Tala, District Raigad'.

4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then stated that Applicant has mentioned all these facts in his representation dated 29.07.2024 to 'Joint Secretary, Revenue & Forest Department' requesting for modification of transfer from post of 'Special Deputy Superintendent of Land Records and Enquiry Officer, Mira-Bhayandar, District Thane' to post of 'Deputy Superintendent of Land Records; Shahapur, District Thane'.

5. The learned PO therefore to inform 'Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue & Forest Department' that Order dated 24.07.2024 by 'Revenue & Forest Department' is required to be partially modified to post Applicant as 'Deputy Superintendent of Land Records, Shahapur, District Thane' instead of 'Special Deputy Superintendent of Land Records and Enquiry Officer, Mira-Bhayandar, District Thane' upon due observance in letter and spirit of the provisions of 'Section 2(y)' and 'Section 20(2)' regarding 'Reasonable Accommodation' under 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016'.
