**ORDER**

1. All applications are taken together as the issue involved in the application is one and the same.

2. Heard Smt Punam Mahajan, learned advocate for the applicants and Ms Swati Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents.

3. All the applicants are working as Dog Handlers in Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad since last 8 to 10 years at

Pune. They all are transferred by common transfer order dated 26.9.2020.

4. Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that there are at present 8 dogs in the service and each dog has two Dog Handlers. She submitted that due to the transfer of these six Dog Handlers, five dogs in the Bomb Squad are facing psychological trauma and are therefore reluctant take commands from the new persons. She has submitted that these amounts to the cruelty to the dogs who cannot speak, but they are in the service. She further submits that all the five dogs are very much attached to the respective Dog Handlers and unable to function without them. In support of her submissions, she has relied on letter dated 7.6.2016 written by Superintendent of Police, CID, Pune and another letter dated 17.11.2016 by Special I.G., VIP Security, State Intelligence Department, Mumbai.

5. Learned C.P.O submits that today she has received the papers and she seeks time to file reply.

6. Perused two letters referred above. In both the letters the importance and necessity of the service rendered by these trained Dogs in the Bomb Squad to the Police Department is highlighted. It is also stated specifically that the Dog Handlers are not to be transferred till a particular dog retires from the service. The officers sending the letters have referred to the Circular Memorandum No. 2/Police (Sports)/2008 (2)-1141, Intelligence Bureau (Ministry of Home affairs) government of India dated 17.6.2008, wherein it is stated as under:-

“Besides it is important that the handler of the dog is not changed during the operational life time of the Dog.”

7. Thus the Dog and Dog Handler work as a team and they should not be separated in the interest of bringing about overall and significant improvement in the performance of sniffer dogs.

8. The dogs are employed in the Dog Squad who are salaried and their date of retirement is also fixed on the basis of their life span and performance. However, this is that class of employees, who cannot speak and take up their grievances, hence all the more those unspoken to be heard and also attended immediately. The transfer of the dog Handlers undoubtedly leads tremendous mental trauma to the dog and therefore, in the interest of Bomb Disposal Squad, I hereby stay all the transfer orders of these Dog Handlers.

9. If at all they are relieved and the transfer orders are now stayed; Dog Handlers are to be sent back to Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad and allow to handle the same dogs with immediate effect.

10. The Commissioner of Police, Pune is directed to consider this issue of transfer of the Dog Handlers in view of Circular Memorandum dated 17.6.2008 and also the Maharashtra Police Dog Squad Manual, Chapter-I, 4 (5) (b) (c).

The Applicant was promoted in the cadre of Joint District Registrar (Class-1) Selection Grade by order dated 04.01.2019 by giving division at Kokan -2. However, his posting was kept in abeyance for long time and during the pendency of O.A. , he was posted by order dated 13.09.2019 at Solapur. The said officer was to inform who are posted to these three posts, (1) Awal Karkoon, Jamabandi, Igatpuri, (2) Awal Karkoon, Employment Guarantee Scheme (E.G.S.), Dindori and (3) Awal Karkoon, Dindori Nashik. However, this query is avoided in the reply dated 15.09.2020.</p> <p>3. I am informed by learned P.O. that these posts are still vacant, however, if the applicant's transfer is cancelled and if at all she is posted on either of these three posts then other Government servants are likely to make the similar representation and flood gate will be opened.</p> <p>4. Considered the submissions made by learned Counsel for the Applicant and learned P.O. for the Respondents and on perusal of the affidavit filed by the concerned officer, it is found that the applicant was posted to Nandgaon during the session of the counseling. It is not her regular transfer but she is promoted and thereafter posted so it cannot be considered a mid-term/mid-tenure transfer. At the time</p>

	<p>of giving posting the higher authority along with suitability, competency, availability is also expected to consider the difficulties of the Government servant. There may be medical ground or very peculiar problems faced at home front. If they are considered at that stage by the higher authority while giving posting then the flow of litigation to this Tribunal can be curtailed to certain extent, so also will increase the efficiency.</p> <p>5. In the present case the applicant is a woman - officer having a baby of three years old and shouldering the responsibility of mother-in-law as her husband is posted at District Palghar which is more than 200 kms. away from Nashik. For certain period and at a certain stage, it is necessary to consider sympathetically the case of the Government employee when the vacant post is available.</p> <p>6. In the present case the three posts i.e. (1) Awal Karkoon, Jamabandi, Igatpuri, (2) Awal Karkoon, (E.G.S.), Dindori and (3) Awal Karkoon, Dindori Nashik are lying vacant and though the opportunity was given to the Respondent to answer this query about the vacancy of these 3 posts the Respondent instead of answering the query has made other irrelevant submissions.</p> <p>7. 
