

The present Misc. Application is made by the applicant seeking condonation of delay of about 532 days caused in filing the accompanying O.A. seeking pay scale on the post of Printing Instructor, which is granted to the applicants in O.A. No. 71/2012 working in the Government Polytechnic, Beed.

2. The applicant was appointed on the post of Printing Instructor on 02.02.2006 by the respondent No. 3 i.e. the Joint Director of Technical Education, Aurangabad, thereby he was posted at Government Polytechnic, Beed. The said services came to be confirmed by the order dated 06.10.2006. The pay scale in the advertisement for the post of Printing Instructor was mentioned as Rs. 4000-100-6000, whereas the pay scale of Printing Instructor in Government of Printing Technology, Mumbai was Rs. 5500-175-9000. Therefore, the

respondent No. 4 i.e. the Principal, Government Polytechnic, Beed by communication dated 07.01.2008 requested and recommended the pay scale of Rs. 5500-175-9000 to the Printing Instructors working in Beed Polytechnic.

3. While working as Printing Instructor in Government Polytechnic, Beed, the applicant was on study leave from 01.01.2010 to 26.06.2012. Thereafter, he resumed the duty on 26.06.2012. During the service, the applicant applied for the post of Lecturer, Group-A for Packing Technology in Government Polytechnic as per MPSC advertisement. The applicant was selected and recommended to the said post. He came to be appointed on that post in the Government Polytechnic, Nagpur as per the G.R. dated 25.07.2014. Since then he is working there. For that purpose, he was relieved from Government Polytechnic, Beed on 19.08.2014, so as to join on the post of Lecturer in Government Polytechnic, Nagpur.

4. Meanwhile, three Printing Instructors from Beed Government Polytechnic filed O.A. No. 71/2012 before this Tribunal seeking pay scale of Rs. 5000-9000 at par with Printing Instructors working in Government Institute of Printing Technology, Mumbai. This Tribunal allowed the said O.A. No. 71/2012 by the order dated 10.12.2014. The respondents therein filed W.P. No. 1017/2016 before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court challenging the said order passed in O.A. No. 71/2012. The said W.P. came to be dismissed.

5. In view of above, the applicant made representation through proper channel to the respondent authorities on 11.10.2017 seeking pay scale as granted to the Printing Instructors by judgment and order dated 10.12.2014 in O.A. No. 71/2012 for the period he worked as Printing Instructor in Government Polytechnic Beed from 08.02.2006 to 19.08.2014 excluding study leave period. The respondent No. 4 recommended the case of the applicant. The applicant did not get necessary benefits. There is delay in filing the

accompanying O.A., but the delay is not deliberate or intentional. The applicant has good case on merits. Meanwhile there was COVID-19 pandemic situation and as such, the delay is caused, which is sought by condoned.

6. The affidavit in reply is not filed on behalf of respondents, though several opportunities were granted.

7. We have heard the arguments advanced by Shri C.R. Thorat, learned Advocate for the applicant on one hand and Shri B.S. Deokar, learned Presenting Officer for the respondents on the other hand.

8. The present delay condonation application along with accompanying O.A. is filed on 15.11.2021. The alleged cause of action arose when the said benefits were granted to the similarly situated persons as per the order dated 10.12.2021 passed in O.A. No. 71/2012 and which order was confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.

1017/2016 by order dated 29.06.2016, as the same was dismissed.

9. In view of the same, the accompanying O.A. ought to have been filed on or before 29.06.2017. However, the same is filed on or about 15.11.2021. In view of the same, there is delay of about 4 years and 4 months caused in filing the accompanying O.A. and not for 532 days as sought to be contended in M.A.

10. After decision of the Hon'ble High Court, the applicant made representation in October 2017 seeking arrears. However, thereafter, the applicant did not follow the matter. In these circumstances, some negligence can be attributed to the applicant on that count. However, it cannot be said to be gross negligence. Thereby the applicant had nothing to gain.

11. It appears that the applicant has a viable case on merit, which requires consideration. In the circumstances as above, in our considered opinion, this is a fit case to consider the reason mentioned by the applicant liberally and to condone the delay by

Application is made by the applicant seeking condonation of delay of about one year and three months caused in filing the accompanying O.A. challenging the impugned order dated 12.12.2018 (Annexure A-5 in O.A.) issued by the respondent No. 4, whereby the name of the applicant is deleted from the waiting list of getting compassionate appointment on the ground of age bar and seeking further direction for getting temporary appointment as earlier.

2. The applicant's mother was working in Group-D post in the office of respondent No. 3 i.e. Dean, Government Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad. She died in harness on 23.02.2012. The applicant made application for seeking compassionate appointment. The respondent No. 3 considered the claim of the applicant & gave appointment order dated 23.08.2013 (Annexure A-2

in O.A.) on compassionate ground. The applicant worked on Group-D post in the office of respondent No. 3 from 2013 to 2019 for more than 7 years. When he joined on the said post, he was within age limit.

3. The respondent No. 4, however, subsequently by impugned order / letter dated 12.12.2018 deleted the name of the applicant from waiting list on the ground that the applicant had completed 45 years of age and further directed that temporary appointment order will not be issued from 2019 to him. Thereafter, the applicant made representations dated 27.02.2019, 21.05.2019 and 03.06.2019 requesting respondent No. 3 to consider his claim for appointment. But there was no response.

4. Thereafter Covid-19 pandemic situation was erupted. Moreover, the applicant is handicapped person. In view of the same, he could not file the O.A. in time. Hence, the present Misc. Application filed for condonation of delay.

5. The affidavit in reply is filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4 by one Dr. Pratibha Ramchandra Deshmukh, working as Assistant Professor, Department of Physiology, in the office of Dean, Government Medical College and Hospital, Aurangabad. Thereby he denied all the adverse contentions raised in the M.A. and contended that the applicant has no case on merit. 2. The applicant was initially appointed as bonded candidate as Medical Officer w.e.f. 03.06.1986 to 02.06.1989. Thereafter he came to be selected by MPSC and was appointed vide order dated 08.02.1999. Since then the applicant was continuously working on the said post of Medical Officer Group-A till acceptance of his voluntary retirement notice dated 29.08.2009 w.e.f. 09.06.2006.

3. It is submitted that the applicant completed his probation period and vide order dated 04.08.1993, the respondent No. 1 terminated probation period.

4. The applicant worked at various places. Vide order dated 19.06.1999, the applicant was transferred from Primary Health Centre, Dhamangaon, Taluka Ashti, District Beed to Rural Hospital, Dharmabad, Taluka Dharmabad, Dist. Nanded. On 19.06.1999, the applicant sought to join his transferred place pursuant to his transfer order dated 19.06.1999, but he was not allowed to join on that post.

5. The Zilla Parishad, Nanded wrote a letter dated 18.07.1999 stating that the applicant was not permitted to join on the said post. The applicant again on 31.07.1999 gave his joining report in the office of respondent No. 4 i.e. the District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad, Beed and requested to post him at Primary Health Centre, Dharmabad, where he was previously working. The respondent No. 4 vide it's letter dated 23.08.1999 addressed to the respondent No. 1 sought guidance as to whether the applicant should be kept without posting or to allow him at previous post. The respondent No. 1 did not respond.

6. The applicant thereafter on 08.09.2006 gave notice for voluntary retirement. There was no response to that from the respondent authorities. Therefore, the applicant filed O.A. No. 86/2018. The said O.A. was allowed by the order dated 23.03.2009. In view of that the respondent authorities on 29.08.2009 accepted voluntary retirement w.e.f. 10.09.2006.

7. While deciding the voluntary retirement application, the period from 19.06.1999 till 09.09.2006 was not taken into consideration by the respondent authorities and no decision is being taken in respect of this period. Thereafter, the respondent No. 4 wrote a letter dated 13.04.2010 to the respondent No. 1 stating that the period of the applicant from 19.06.1999 to 09.09.2006 is not being decided and therefore, pension papers also cannot be finalized. The applicant approached the respondent authorities in the year 2019 and 2020 on several occasions. But no decision is taken. The applicant has good case on merits. In fact, the cause of action is recurring one. However, even if there is delay if any, it can be condoned.

8. The affidavit in reply jointly filed on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and separately on behalf of respondent No. 4, thereby they have denied all the adverse contentions raised in the present M.A. and contended that no sufficient cause is shown by the applicant for condonation of delay. It appears that the applicant has not raised grievance before the respondent No. 1. Hence, the present M.A. is liable to be dismissed.

9. We have heard the arguments advanced by Shri V.B. Wagh, learned Advocate for the applicant on one hand and Smt. Deepali S. Deshpande, learned Presenting Officer for the respondents on the other hand.

10. The applicant filed the present Misc. Application along with accompanying O.A. seeking various reliefs and more particularly seeking direction to the respondent No. 1 to take decision of the period of 19.06.1999 to 09.09.2006 by treating it as per the Rule 9(14) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Services) Rule, 1981 and also period w.e.f. 30.06.1986 till 08.02.1990 to

Thereafter, the applicant said to have made representation dated 13.04.2010 and visited the office of respondent authorities thrice in the year 2019 and once in the year 2022. The applicant is claiming monetary benefits including pensionary benefits. In such circumstances, in our considered opinion, liberal approach should be adopted in appreciating the 'sufficient cause' for condonation of delay. Hence, this is a fit case to condone the delay by imposing moderate costs on the applicant. We compute the costs of Rs. 1000/- to be paid by the applicant. In the result, we proceed to pass following order :-
