

The Applicant stands retired on 28.02.2020 but his gratuity and regular pension is not paid, and therefore, he has filed present O.A. 3. Learned P.O. sought to contend that the Pay Verification Unit has raised objection which resulted in delay in releasing gratuity. Indeed, in terms of Rule 120 to 122 of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 appropriate steps for preparation of pension paper ought to have been started well in advance i.e. before two years of date of retirement. However, no such steps were taken as mandated in rules. 4. On the contrary, the perusal of Affidavit in Reply reveals that the service book was sent on 02.08.2019 i.e. only before six months of retirement which ought to have been sent before two years of the retirement. 5. As per Affidavit in Rely, there seems to be some dispute about pensionable pay and entitlement for benefit of 10/20/30 years benefit of ACP in terms of G.R. dated 02.03.2019. Therefore, the department has sought guidance from the Respondent No.1- Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department as seen from letter dated 11.11.2022. However, no further steps are taken by the Home Department in the matter. Thus, the Respondent No.1 seems to be sitting over the matter though the period of near about 3 years is now over from the date of retirement of the Applicant. [P.T.O.]

8. The Respondents are directed to release gratuity and regular pension of the Applicant as per his entitlement in Rules within six weeks from today.
9. The Applicant is at liberty to redress his grievance of interest on belated payment independently.
