2. The Applicant who retired as a Higher Grade Stenographer on 31.12.2020 challenges the order of recovery dated 04.12.2020 to the tune of Rs.2,82,875/-. The learned Counsel submits that recovery is due to the wrong fixation of pay scale. He further submits that already amount of Rs.20,000/- is recovered from her salary when she was in the service.

3. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
