Issue of entitlement for pay and allowance for the period of suspension is to be considered after decision in D.E. but in present case no such D.E. is initiated though period of more than two years is over.

6. Learned Advocate for the Applicant has filed Affidavit-in-Rejoinder on behalf of the Applicant. It is taken on record. In Affidavit-in-Rejoinder it is stated that nothing is culminated against the Applicant in the enquiry and no criminal case is initiated against him.
