ORDER

1) Heard Shri K.R. Jagdale, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent.

2) The Applicant is working as Assistant Police Inspector and posted at Rabale, Police Station under establishment of Navi Mumbai; police. Applicant prays to quash and set aside the order of his Preliminary Enquiry (P.E.), dated 17.04.2020 issued by Respondent No.1, Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai. The Applicant when working at control room at Navi Mumbai, was punished for not following the protocol of giving some serious information to his immediate superior i.e. Joint Commissioner of Police.

His one year increment is stopped. Against the said minor penalty he has filed appeal to the Government which is pending before Government. The said order is not the subject matter of this O.A.

3) It is the case of the Applicant that his immediate superior for his fault of not reporting to him about the serious information, abused him in front of many police personnel and humiliated him. Being aggrieved with the said insult, he himself made station dairy entry at control room stating that his superior has committed offence and therefore action be taken against his immediate superior. Thereafter, he submitted an Application at C.B.D. Police station on 08.02.2020 with similar details, so that offence can be registered against the superior officer. This act of the Applicant has invited displeasure of his superior that action of making such station dairy entry and giving the Application is against the discipline and the protocol of Police department.

4) The Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai, therefore on 17.04.2020 issued order of P.E. of the Applicant for misconduct and irresponsible behavior. The Applicant has therefore approached the Tribunal against said order of conducting of P.E., and prayed to stay the same.

5) We heard both the counsel for the Applicant and Respondent. We are of the opinion that the Applicant has been given the minor penalty for not following the protocol. *Prime-facie* the Applicant should not have made such entry in the station dairy of the control room against his senior. Since serious information involving V.V.I.P. was involved, the senior officer used abusive language which was uncalled for. It is improper to humiliate the subordinate Police personnel. The things could have been settled by admonishing the Applicant by adhering to the propriety.

6) Had Applicant tendered regrets for writing such entries the matter could have been doused there and then. We therefore, asked learned counsel appearing for the Applicant to take instructions telephonically whether the Applicant is ready to admit his mistake of writing station dairy and this statement is to be made before the Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai, That station dairy entry will be withdrawn by him. So also on the other hand, concerned senior officer also to withdraw abusive words he has used at that time. This is to be said & done before the Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai. On obtaining instructions from the applicant telephonically the learned Counsel submits that he is ready to make this statement without prejudice subject to the outcome and the decision of the Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai and subject to closure of P.E. against him.

7) We are of the opinion that the officer who was immediate superior at the relevant time also to take note and the matter should not be stretched further as the service of each Police personnel is valuable, especially during the situation of COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, we request Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai, to settle the matter so that time of the Police department and Tribunal can be utilized for other

urgent services. This order is passed with a view that matter can be settled at the level of the Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai. If not then whatever statements made before the Commissioner of Police, Navi Mumbai, by the applicant & other are treated without prejudice, and hence cannot be used against any party in further proceedings.

8) Till then P.E. not to proceed against the Applicant and Applicant to join the service by 03.07.2020 at Rabale, Police Station.
