1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, the learned Advocate for the Applicants and Shri K.B. Bhise, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. Heard both sides.

3. At this stage, Smt. Punam Mahajan, the learned Advocate for the Applicants prays for leave to correct the nomenclature of Respondent no.3.

4. Leave to amend for correction is granted.

5. Respondent No.3, Maharashtra Public Service Commission (M.P.S.C.) has tendered short affidavit-in-reply, furtherance to the query posed by this Tribunal during the hearing on 01.08.2017. Affidavit-in-reply is taken on record.

6. Heard both sides on admission as well as on Interim relief.

7. Original Application is admitted.



### Applicants' grievance in nutshell is as follows :-8.

- (a) The State Government and M.P.S.C. have adopted the practice of conducting the screening tests for selection of candidates for final written examination, merit ranking wherein would be considered as merit ranking for appointment for the post of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector.
- (b) The actual eligibility of candidates based on recruitment rules would be verified by the State Government after M.P.S.C sends the list of 833 candidates who may be selected.
- (c) After the list of selected candidates would be sent by M.P.S.C., certain number of candidates in whose case it would be found that they are lacking
- in basic eligibility, as prescribed under the recruitment rules are bound to be eliminated.
- (d) As per Rule 23 of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure, 2014, M.P.S.C. has to limit the number of candidates for final selection which has to be 8 times the number of candidates to be selected and approximately 10 times the number of each category of reservation in the vacancies.
- (e) Considering that after selection large number of candidates would be possibly eliminated due to their failure to comply with the eligibility prescribed by the rules, number of candidates selected by M.P.S.C. would be far less in number than the number of candidates to be invited for main examination by observing the preposition of 1:8 in totality and 1:10 in relation to each category.

Therefore, according to Applicants, it is necessary that selection process be interfered and the applicants be allowed to appear for the main examination. 9.

When case was heard yesterday, the figure of total number of candidates being called was not clearly available. At that time, it was, prima facie, noticed that if the 10. ratio of 1:8 and 1:10 etc. as against the candidates to be appointed is not followed, it still result in breach of Rule 8(ii) of the Maharashtra Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure, 2014 and at the same time is would result in denial of opportunity to candidates who could otherwise enter the field of consideration but had to remain outside, because they were not selected for admission to main examination.

11. Therefore, this Tribunal has orally directed the M.P.S.C. to furnish the figures and / or ratio of candidates called for main examination, enable this Tribunal to know as to whether the candidates now being called are proportionately more in number than the 1:8 or 1:10 ratio as the case be.

12. In the affidavit-in-reply which is filed today and from oral submissions, the figures which have surfaced are as follows :-

(a)	Number of posts to be filed.	:	833
(b)	Number of candidates who are selected for main . examination	:	9870
(c)	Statutory proportion which is required.	:	1:8
(d)	Statutory proportion which is required category- wise.	:	1:10
(e)	Number of candidates required to be called considering 833 vacancies by observing the ratio 1:8 comes to.	:	6664
(f)	Number of candidates who are called for main examination	:	9870
(g)	Ratio	:	11.84

13. Yesterday during the hearing, this Tribunal had also asked M.P.S.C. to calculate the number of candidates who may have to be called, if the bench-mark is varied / reduced by 1 mark.

14. Today learned P.O. for the Respondents has tendered in the sealed cover which contains the letter received from the agency from whom certain work of examination is outsourced. This Tribunal has opened the said envelope. The letter contained therein states that if the bench mark is reduced by 1 mark (excluding the categories where bench mark which is fixed is only one mark), number of qualifying candidates for main examination would increase to 11240.

18. Thus Applicants have not made out the case worth grant of interim relief, hence, prays for interim relies is rejected.
