


The Applicant was kept on Wait List at Sr. No. 1 in the open category in the requirement held by MPSC for the post of 'Assistant Public Prosecutor'. Some of the persons aggrieved by the list of eligible candidates have approached to the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad bench raising certain grievances. Having regard to the contentions made therein Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad bench by showing indulgence held that recommendation of candidates made and published on 10.08.2023 is unsustainable in law and issued certain directions. After pronouncement of said Order the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Aurangabad bench directed to maintain status quo. Later the said Order was challenged before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court, Aurangabad bench who it has modified the Order by paving a way for completion of further process by Order dated 21.10.2024. The Applicant states that 2 candidates who were in Select list made correspondence to the MPSC that they have given up their candidature. In that connection communication is made by

5. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that as per Rule the life of Wait List is one year from the date of declaration of result and by way of amendment the stay period if any has been excluded from calculation. It is brought to the notice that the stay/status quo was operating for total 116 days and after exclusion of said period, one year period would expire tomorrow. It is submitted that there is absolutely no fault on the part of Applicant as admittedly he stands at Sr. No. 1 in the Wait list and thus the internal correspondence also shows the requisition is made for his recommendation. Having peculiarity of facts and in Order to protect the Applicant interest, the Applicant's candidature at Wait list No. 1 shall be kept alive till filing of reply by Respondent No. 1 and 2.
