The relevant clause 2 (4A)is as follows: -
  - "2. In the "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations,

1998", in Schedule-I, the following clause shall be added after \$1.No.4:-

"4A. Determination of equivalence of the qualification of DNB (Board Specialities) with MD/MS & DNB (Super-Specialities) with DM/M.Ch."

- 5. The applicant has also demonstrated that respondent No. 2 issued two more advertisements on 27.12.2022 for the post of Senior Pathologist, Specialist [Annexure A-9(i)] and Senior Orthopedic Surgeon, Specialist [Annexure A-9 (ii)]. As per these two advertisements, equivalence qualification of DNB, for the posts of Senior Pathologist, Specialist and Senior Orthopedic Surgeon, Specialist are recognized.
- 6. Recruitment Rules for these posts of Senior Pediatrician, Specialists, Senior Pathologist, Specialist and Senior Orthopedic Surgeon, Specialist are Maharashtra Medical Insurance Services, Group-A (Recruitment) Rules are of the year 1985 initially and Corrigendum of 1988 are material in all the three advertisements issued on the same date. At this stage no response is received especially from

respondent No. 1 in this regard. The interviews for the post of Senior Pediatrician, Specialists is scheduled to be held tomorrow i.e. 3.5.2023. Hence, there is urgency in the matter.

- 6. The applicant made earlier application for the post of Senior Pediatrician on 19.1.2023 (Annexure A-5). Before that the applicant sent email dated 10.1.2023 and 19.1.2023 placing on record difficulties in filling up the form showing his DNB degree which is equivalent to the MD (Pediatrician). In view of the same, the impugned reason of alleged misrepresentation of M.D. degree requires further consideration, which can be done in hearing of the O.A.

At this interim stage, in our opinion, the interest of the applicant can be protected by allowing him to appear in the oral interview and more particularly by giving

directions to respondent No. 2, the Maharashtra Public Service Commission, to call the applicant, as well as, similarly situated candidates holding DNB, if any for oral interview and making this process subject to outcome of this O.A. It is ordered accordingly. The result of the applicant and similarly situated candidates, if any be placed in sealed envelope and to open it at appropriate stage under order from this Tribunal. 2. This is an application seeking condonation of delay which has occurred in filing the annexed Original Application by the applicant. It is the contention of the applicant that he was constantly pursuing the respondents by filing representations to them, thereby ventilating his grievance and last such representation was rejected on 4.10.2016. It is the further contention of the applicant that thereafter the applicant suffered from hypertension and spondylolysis and was required to undergo long treatment. At the similar time his wife also was suffering from certain age related diseases. It is the further contention of the applicant that the delay

has thus occurred of 27 months and 21 days in approaching the Tribunal by the applicant. The learned counsel submitted that having regard to the genuine difficulties as are mentioned in the application, the delay may be condoned so that the applicant can prosecute his Original Application on merits.

3. Respondent no. 4 has filed the affidavit in reply and has resisted the contentions raised in the Misc. It is the contention of the learned Application. Presenting Officer that the representation of the applicant has been rejected much prior to filing of the present application and as such delay is of the period more than claimed by the applicant. learned Presenting Officer submitted that in the year 2003 recovery was directed and notice in that regard was issued and served upon the applicant and the entire amount was recovered in the year 2005. In the circumstances, according to learned Presenting Officer, cause of action had arisen in the year 2005. The learned Presenting Officer further submitted that, mere making of representations one after

another will not save the period of limitation and the Tribunal shall not entertain such belated claim. The learned Presenting Officer has, therefore, prayed for rejection of the present application.

- 4. I have duly considered the submissions advanced on behalf of the applicant, as well as, the respondents. In the Original Application the applicant has made the following prayers:-
  - "A. Original Application may be allowed.
  - B. By way of appropriate order or direction in the like nature, the respondent No. 3 may be directed to refund entire amount received from the applicant on the ground of excess payment made to him due to wrong pay fixation with interest at the rate of 12% from the date of recovery.
  - C. By way of appropriate order or direction in like nature, the respondent no. 3 may be directed to fix the correct and proper pay scale of the applicant and send fresh proposal of his pension and other benefits to the A.G., Nagpur.
  - D. Any other suitable and equitable relief may be granted in favour of petitioner and oblige."

- 5. On going through the documents filed on record in the Original Application it is revealed that revised pay fixation in respect of the pay of the applicant was carried out in the year 2003 and in the said pay fixation it was noticed that pay of the applicant was wrongly fixed and accordingly his pay was revised. In the revision it was noticed that the applicant has been paid during the intervening period amount of Rs. 41,008/- in excess than his entitlement. The said amount has been recovered from the applicant in the year 2005. The record further reveals that the very first representation taking exception to the revision of pay and recovery directed against the applicant was filed in the year 2011. Thereafter another representation was made on 29.9.2016 and the said representation was rejected by the respondents on 4.10.2016.
- 6. From the facts, which have come on record it is evident that in fact the cause of action had arisen in the year 2005 itself when the amount of Rs. 41,008/- was recovered from the applicant on account of excess payment made to the applicant

because of the wrong fixation of his pay. It would be useful to see what actions were taken by the applicant against the order so passed and the recovery so made by the respondents. As per the contention of the applicant himself the first representation was made by the applicant on 30.5.2011 i.e. 6 years after the recovery was made. This is also a quite long period and the applicant has not provided any explanation why he did not take any action for long 6 years. The record shows that thereafter another representation was made by the applicant on 22.9.2016 i.e. after about 5 years of the first representation. The applicant has not provided any explanation as to why he remained silent after making representation in the year 2011 till 2016. The said representation dated 22.9.2016 has been rejected by the respondents vide the impugned order passed on 4.10.2016. Even thereafter the applicant took 5 years to approach this Tribunal.

7. As is revealing from the contentions raised in the present Misc. Application the applicant is

reckoning the period for delay from the date of rejection of his representation by the respondents on 4.10.2016. As held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Union of India and Others Vs. Chaman Rana, (2018) 3 SCR 640 decided on March 12, 2018 "mere repeated filing of representations could not be sufficient explanation for delay in approaching the Court for grant of relief." I reiterate that the cause of action first arose in the year 2005 when the recovery was actually effected from the wages of the applicant. The representation made thereafter by the applicant one in 2011 and another in 2016 would not save the limitation and as held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court that could not be sufficient explanation for the delay in approaching the Tribunal. It is quite clear that the applicant was not at all diligent in prosecuting his claim. In absence of any cogent and sufficient explanation provided by the applicant for the delay occasioned of more than 15 years in approaching the Tribunal, no case is made out by the applicant for condoning the inordinate delay so occurred. Hence the following order:-

- 2. It is the grievance of the applicant in the present Original application that though she is physically disabled and percentage of her disability is more than 40% she has been transferred on promotion to a place at the distance of 198 KMs from her existing place of posting.
- 3. The applicant was working as Staff Nurse at Jalna and was promoted to the post of Nurse vide order dated 2.8.2021. On promotion she was transferred from Jalna to Hingoli. Accordingly the applicant has joined at Civil Hospital, Hingoli. It is the contention of the applicant that though she has

made a request to give her posting at Jalna or at nearby place by filing representation to the respondents. However, her said request has not yet been considered. Applicant has relied upon the Government Notification dated 15.12.2004. The applicant therefore has filed the present Original Application with the following prayers:-

### "Relief Sought -

- (a) The Original Application may kindly be allowed.
- (b) Record and Proceedings may kindly be called for.
- (c) The Hon'ble Court be pleased to direct the respondent no. 4 to consider the application for transfer dated 12.8.2021 and to grant her transfer to General Civil Hospital Jalna."
- 4. The request of the applicant has been opposed by the respondents on the ground that the Government Notification dated 15.12.2004 on which the applicant has placed reliance is applicable only in the cases of transfers and not in the event of promotion.

- 5. The defence so raised is unconscionable. May be on promotion but the applicant has been ultimately transferred from her existing place. In the circumstances, it is unacceptable that the provisions in the Notification dated 15.12.2004 would not be applicable in the case of the applicant.
- 6. The Government Circular dated 15.12.2004 issued by its General Administration Department provides that so far as the physically disabled employees in the Government service are concerned, they shall be transferred as far as possible at the nearest place of their native place as per the administrative convenience. As I have noted hereinabove the guidelines so provided vide the aforesaid Circular would be equally applicable in the case of transfer of an employee on promotion.
- 7. In fact, the respondents must have endeavored to give posting to the applicant after her promotion at a near place to Jalna. Higoli is at the distance of 198 KMs from Jalna as has been submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant. The applicant has obeyed the said order and has

resumed at Hingoli and has been working there for last about 2 years. She has made a representation praying therein for her transfer at Jalna or at the nearby place on 12.8.2021. The Civil Surgeon, Civil Hospital, Hingoli has recommended for her transfer while forwarding as prayed bv her her representation dated 12.8.2021 to the Deputy Director of Health Services i.e. respondent no. 3. The said representation has not been considered. The respondents have not provided any explanation considering said for not the representation till date.

8. After having considered the facts involved in the present matter it appears to me that the request made by the applicant is worth considering and having regard to the Circular dated 15.12.2004 the respondents are expected to favourably consider the request made by the applicant. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order:-

#### ORDER

(i) Respondent nos. 2 and 3 shall favourably consider the request of the applicant and give her

posting as far as posting at Jalna or else at the place near from Jalna in the General Transfers of the current year.

(ii) The Original Application stands allowed in the aforesaid terms without any order as to costs.
