- 2. The applicant, Professor in Obstetrics and Gynecology, in J.J Hospital, Mumbai, challenges the transfer order dated 31.12.2021 transferring her from Mumbai to Rajshree Chatrapati Shahu Maharaj Government Medical College, Kolhapur.
- Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant was earlier transferred to Ambejogai in the year 2019. She went there and worked for 5 months. However, she made representation on account of her family responsibilities to transfer her back to Mumbai. The Government responded positively and she was transferred back to from Ambejogai to Mumbai in September, 2020. However, after one year and 3 months, she has been transferred mid-term and midtenure in violation of Section 4(4) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred as 'ROT Act 2005' for brevity).
- 4. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that she has earlier complained against one Dr Ashok Anand of humiliation and harassment in which Dr Ashok Anand was held guilty by Enquiry Committee and he was also sent on deputation to Ambejogai before the applicant was transferred to Ambejogai. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits after five months the applicant was brought back and she started working at J.J Hospital, Mumbai. Learned counsel further submits that it is the case of the applicant that two junior Doctors of Dr Ashok Anand, one Dr Kuravde and Dr Palve started harassing her and making complaints against her at the instance of Dr Ashok Anand and that is the root cause of this matter.
- 5. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that applicant has two daughters studying in 7th & 8th standard and her husband has undergone angioplasty on 1.12.2021. She submits that all allegations made against her are false. In view of the above circumstances, it is very difficult for her to go to Kolhapur and work there. - 2. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that by order dated 18.11.2021 this Tribunal stayed the impugned reversion order dated 29.4.2021 and applicant was to be brought back to his original post of Laboratory Technician. But the said order is not yet executed by the respondents.
- 3. Ld. PO submits that applicant is 100% blind. On query Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that he is 90% blind by one eye and 100% blind by other eye.
- 4. We make it clear that by order dated 18.11.2021 reversion was stayed and he was to be brought back to his original post of Laboratory Technician. However, Laboratory Technician needs good eye sight and there may be errors in the report of the patients which should not take place. However, we draw the attention of the respondents to first and second provisos to Section 20 of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 which reads as follows:

"Provided that, if an employee after acquiring disability is not suitable for the post he was holding, shall be shifted to some other post with the same pay scale and service benefits;

Provided further that if it is not possible to adjust the employee against any post, he may be kept on a supernumerary post until a suitable post is available or he attains the age of superannuation, whichever is earlier."

- 1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B.K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Matter is taken up for hearing at the stage of admission.
- 3. The Applicant is Jail Guard. He was suspended by order dated 23.09.2021 in contemplation of D.E. invoking Rule 4(1)(a) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979. He made representation for revocation of suspension on the ground of prolong suspension but it is not responded.
- 4. Learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that since suspension was in contemplation of D.E. and period of more than 90 days is over, the Applicant is entitled to reinstatement in terms of decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2015) 7 SCC 291 (Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India & Anr.). He has further pointed out G.R. dated 09.07.2019 issued by Government of Maharashtra in this behalf.
- 5. Learned P.O. submits that review of the suspension will be taken soon.
- 6. As stated above, challenge is to the suspension order dated 23.09.2021 whereby the Applicant is suspended in contemplation of D.E. Admittedly, till date no D.E. is initiated by issuance of charge-sheet though period of more than 90 days is over.

- 7. In view of judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Ajay Kumar Choudhary's Case, Respondent was under obligation to take review of suspension.
- 8. Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Ajay Kumar Choudhary's* Case held that the period of suspension should not exceed beyond three months if charge-sheet is not served upon delinquent and where the charge-sheet is served upon a reason order needs to be passed for the extension of suspension.
- 9. Whereas, in present case admittedly till date no charge-sheet is served upon the delinquent though more than 90 days is over. Government of Maharashtra by G.R. dated 09.07.2019 has also issued clear instructions to the all the Departments for issuance of charge-sheet within 90 days from the date of suspension.
- 10. In view of above, O.A. is disposed of by issuing following direction.
- 11. Respondent is directed to take review of suspension of the Applicant within two weeks from today and the decision as the case may be shall be communicated to the Applicant within a week thereafter.
- 12. If the Applicant felt aggrieved by the decision he is at liberty to avail further legal remedy.
- 13. No order as to costs.
