ORDER

- 1. Heard Shri R.M. Kolge, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Shri A. J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. In this O.A., the Applicant who is serving as Junior Finger Print Expert on the establishment of Respondent No.2- Additional Director General of Police (CID, Pune) has challenged his transfer order dated 24.07.2020 whereby he was transferred from Pune to Chandrapur.



- 3. Perusal of transfer order dated 24.07.2020 as well as on hearing of learned P.O. and Law Officer, it is noticed that the Respondent No.2 has transferred the Applicant invoking provisions of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as 'Act 2005).
- 4. Whereas, the Applicant's Counsel contends that though the Applicant is working as Junior Finger Print Expert his post is equivalent to API and he being working in specialized agency, the provisions of Maharashtra Police Act would apply which *inter-alia* provides for constitution of Police Establishment Board (PEB) for specialized agencies as contemplated under Section 22(J)-3 and 22(J)-4 of Maharashtra Police Act.
- 5. Learned Counsel for the Applicant in this behalf sought to place reliance on the decision rendered by this Tribunal in O.A.No.385/2015 (Shri Gopinath B. Lokhande v/s Additional Director General of Police), decided on 01.12.2015 wherein this Tribunal held that the post of Junior Finger Print Expert is equivalent to Assistant Police Inspector (API) so as to attract Section 22N(1)(e) of Maharashtra Police Act, and further, held that for transfer of such employee there must be compliance of Section 22 J-3 of Maharashtra Police Act. In that case, ultimately the Tribunal quashed the transfer order mainly on the point of non publication of constitution of PEB in official gazette as contemplated under Section 22J-3 of Maharashtra Police Act.
 - 6. Suffice to say, the coordinate bench of this Tribunal in O.A.No.385/2015 has held that the provisions of Maharashtra Police Act would apply.
 - 7. Whereas, learned P.O. sought to contend that after the decision in O.A.No.385/2015, in one another matter i.e. in O.A.No.469/2016 similar issue was raised before this Tribunal and that time after taking opinion of law and judiciary, the Government had issued letter on 24.11.2016 that for transfer of Junior Finger Print Expert, Hand Writing Expert as well as Photographer the

provisions of 'Act 2005' would apply and directions were accordingly issued to the Respondent No.2 to follow procedure under 'Act 2005'.

- 8. It is on the above background, Respondent No.2 transferred the Applicant invoking provisions of 'Act 2005'.
- 9. In view of above, the issue for consideration would be whether the transfer is governed by Maharashtra Police Act or Transfer Act, 2005.
- 10. As stated above, there is decision of this Tribunal in O.A.No.385/2015 that the transfer would be governed by Maharashtra Police Act.
- 11. Learned P.O. submits that in view of interim relief granted in favour of the Applicant, the matter needs to be decided at the earliest.
- 12. However, in my considered opinion having regard to the provisions of Section 2(6), (11A) and Section 3 of Maharashtra Police Act, the post of Junior Finger Print Expert does not fall within the term police force or police personnel. The post of Junior Finger Print Expert is only equated to the post of API by G.R. dated 09.05.2000. The nature of duties required to be performed by Finger Print Expert and police personnel are totally different in nature. Therefore, in my opinion, the transfer of Junior Finger Print Expert is governed by 'Act 2005' and not by Maharashtra Police Act.
- 13. Since, there is a contrary decision of coordinate bench in O.A.No.385/2015, the judicial propriety demands that the issue needs to be finally decided by the Division Bench.
- 14. In view of above, it would be appropriate that the matter is placed before the Division Bench to answer the following reference:-
- (A) Whether the transfer of Junior Finger Print Expert working on the establishment of Respondent No.2 is governed by Maharashtra Police Act or by

provision of Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005.

15. Registrar is, therefore, directed to place the matter before the Hon'ble Chairperson for appropriate orders.

- 2. Perusal of record reveals that this O.A. was lastly listed before the Tribunal on 27.03.2020 and thereafter it remained unlisted due to Covid-19 Pandemic situation and lockdown.
- 3. In view of above Applicant and his Advocate both seems unaware about today's hearing.
- 4. I therefore think it appropriate to give them one opportunity of hearing instead of dismissing the O.A. today.
- 5. Adjourned for Final Hearing.
