2. In this matter learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that the results of the Applicant have been declared on 18.11.2022 and he has secured total marks of 165 from the Orphan Category. His name has been recommended in the provisional list. This Tribunal had passed an interim order wherein we have given direction to MPSC to allow the Applicant to participate in the Main examination of Sales Tax Inspector (S.T.I.) & P.S.I. Pursuant to this order Applicant was allowed to appear for the examination and Applicant appeared in examination only for the post of S.T.I. We had allowed the Applicant to appear for the examination because of the delay on the part of District Women and Child Development Department to give Orphan certificate to the Applicant. The Applicant received the Orphan certificate on 18.10.2021 which was beyond the cut-off date i.e. 19.03.2021 though he had applied for the certificate prior to the last date. In such circumstances we confirm our interim relief granted on his participation in the selection process.

3. We therefore direct the M.P.S.C. to recommend his case, if otherwise found eligible. With these observations O.A. is allowed and disposed of.






