In this OA the applicant is working as Assistant in the establishment of Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority, Mumbai since 26.9.2005 and seeks promotion to the post of Establishment Officer.</p> <p>3. At the outset, Ld. CPO submits that the OA is not maintainable on the ground of jurisdiction of the Tribunal as the applicant is working in the Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority, High Court, Mumbai and the said establishment comes under the Hon'ble High Court. She states that under Section 2(c) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 the provisions of this Act are not applicable to any officer or servant of the Supreme Court or of any High Court or Courts subordinate thereto.</p> <p>4. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant is appointed by the Law and Judiciary Department as an Assistant in the Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority. Ld. Advocate submits that Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority comes under the Law & Judiciary Department and therefore applicant is a Government servant. He relied on office order dated 25.6.2015 issued by the Secretary of the High Court Legal Services Committee, Mumbai thereby appointing the applicant on the establishment of High Court Legal Services Committee w.e.f. 19.6.2015. He has further relied on letter dated 21.1.2012 issued by Member Secretary, Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority, High Court, Mumbai by which the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is requested give preference to the feeder cadre</p> <p align="right">[PTO.]</p>

staff members who were permanently absorbed on the establishment of DLSA while filling up various vacant posts before calling willingness from the establishment of District Court and High Court, Bombay and its Benches at Nagpur and Aurangabad.

5. He further submits that the applicant has made representation dated 16.6.2022 to the Hon'ble Chairman, Shri Justice S.S. Shinde, High Court Legal Services Committee, Mumbai and the Hon'ble Chairman has recommended her name to the Government. He further points out letter dated 1.2.2023 wherein Under Secretary, Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority has written to the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee about the appointment of respondent no.5 as Establishment Officer from post of Deputy Registrar, Small Causes Court. He then relied on office order dated 5.5.2011 issued by Secretary, High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Aurangabad Bench appointing Shri N.K. Jadhav, Offtg. Assistant on the establishment of High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Aurangabad as Establishment Officer on the establishment of High Court Legal Services Sub-Committee, Aurangabad.

6. We have considered submissions of Ld. Advocate for the applicant. Perused all the documents relied on. This OA is filed on complete misconception of law. The applicant, as pointed out by the Ld. CPO, was appointed by order dated 26.9.2005 as Officiating Clerk/Typist on the establishment of Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority, Mumbai. The applicant initially has appeared pursuant to the advertisement for departmental examination for the post of Clerk-Typist and she was waited listed as per select list. Therefore while filling up the post in the Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority she was given appointment in 2005. The employees working in Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority, High Court come under the establishment of High Court as their parent department is High Court.

7. For the aforesaid reasons the OA deserves to be dismissed. Hence, OA is dismissed. No order as to costs.




