ORDER

1. Heard Shri S.B. Deshpande, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Ms. N.G. Gohad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. It is seen that amended O.A. is served on the Respondents on 15.06.2017.

3. Ms. N.G. Gohad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents states that Shri Yashwant S. Chatekar, Junior Clerk, Small Scale Irrigation, (Water Conservation), Division Sangli has arrived to give instructions.

4. It is seen that the subject matter to challenge is the charge-sheet by the Government which is signed by the Deputy Secretary of the Water Resources Department. It is shocking that the Government is not serious in contesting the matter, in the background that the charge-sheet is issued by the Government and a Clerk from the office of Irrigation Division is sent for giving instructions.

5. After above observation was dictated learned P.O. had sought time and contacted the Department. Later on Shri Jadhav, Section Officer, Water Resources Department, Mantralaya has arrived to give instructions to learned P.O..

6. This Tribunal had made an enquiry as to whether the Principal Secretary, concerned has himself read the papers and the law before signing the office note, proposing to issue charge-sheet under challenge.

7. Learned P.O. has taken instructions from the officer who has arrived and on instructions states that the Principal Secretary has read the papers and thereafter endorsed the file for the signature of the Hon'ble Minister concerned, and after approval of the Hon'ble Minister, the charge-sheet has been issued.

8. It is seen that the Applicant has raised two grounds inter alia various other grounds. These two important grounds are namely as follows :-

- (a) The charge-sheet is in violation of the bar created by virtue of 27(2)(b)(ii) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982.
- (b) Other delinquents to whom the composite charge-sheet consisting of same charge-sheets on facts was issued of which transaction present applicant was a co-delinquent, have been cleared off of the said mis-conduct.

9. In the above background, this Tribunal has raised queries as to whether the Principal Secretary who plays the role, not only of the officer in the chain of hierarchy, but also functions as a legal advisor, was himself expected to read the provisions of Rules 27 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 and then to decide as to whether service of charge-sheet was to be legal due to bar carved out in Rule 27(2)(b)(ii) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982.

10. Whatever may be the history now this Tribunal wants the Principal Secretary to do the some exercise.

11. Learned P.O. is directed to furnish the name of the incumbent holding the post of Principal Secretary, Water Resources Department, Mantralaya.

Learned P.O. has furnished the following name : Shri I.S. Chahal, Principal Secretary, Water Resources Department, Mantralaya.

13. Shri I.S. Chahal, Principal Secretary, Water Resources Department, Mantralaya is directed as follows :-

- (a) Call for the entire papers, including present O.A., charge-sheet, entire file in relation thereto.
- (b) Read all papers himself.
- (c) Peruse the contents of the scheme of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 with special focus on the bar created by virtue of 27(2)(b)(ii) of Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982.

- (d) Calculate / reckon and identify exact dates with reference to which the imputations are contained in the charge-sheet for the mis-conduct alleged against the Applicant.
- (e) Calculate days from the commission of alleged mis-conduct and the date of issuance of charge-sheet.
- (f) Find out whether issuance of charge-sheet caused within the tooth of the bar created by the Rule 27 aforesaid.
- (g) After examining all this, file affidavit-in-reply where impugned chargesheet is legal and competent.

14. Learned P.O. states that since, Assembly Session is going to commence in this week, Principal Secretary may be engaged in the work related to the Assembly and therefore longer time may be granted.

15. Learned P.O. for the Respondents prays for four week's time.

16. Whatever may be the volume of work at hand, for an officer of the rank of Principal Secretary, an hour may be too much for studying present case, particularly, when he is assisted by large battery of seasoned officers working under him. Therefore, request for four week's for filing affidavit is not acceptable.

17. Affidavit on the foregoing points stated in paragraph 13 may be filed on or before 27.07.2017.

18. S.O. to 27.07.2017.
