- The applicant is officer falling in Group-A 2. category and was promoted to the post of Assistant Commissioner vide order dated 27.04.2022 and posted at District Skill Development, Employment Entrepreneurship Guidance and Centre. Aurangabad. The ordinary tenure of the applicant to remain on the said post is of 3 years. He has order transferred vide however, been 01.08.2023 from Aurangabad to Sindhudurg on the The aforesaid order has been vacant post. challenged by the applicant in the present Original Application.
- 3. Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that before giving posting to the applicant on the promotional post of Assistant Commissioner, Skill Development, he was required to give his option for

the Division. Accordingly, the applicant on 07.01.2022 has submitted option in writing for Aurangabad Revenue Division. Thereafter, he was posted at Aurangabad.

Learned counsel submitted that when the 4. applicant was having ordinary tenure of 3 years to remain on the present post at Aurangabad, he has been abruptly transferred vide impugned order that too at the faraway district of Sindhudurg. Learned counsel submitted that in the order of transfer nothing has been disclosed as to on what ground or for what reasons the applicant has been shifted from Aurangabad in mid-term and mid-tenure. Learned counsel further invited my attention to Notification dated 14.07.2021, whereby Rules called as Maharashtra Government Allotment of Revenue Division for Appointment by Nomination Promotion to the post of Group-A and Group-B (Gazetted and Non-Gazetted) Rules, 2021 notified and more particularly Rule 8 and Rule 15 thereof. Rule 8 provides that the officers in Group-A and Group-B appointed either by direct recruitment or by promotion shall complete the tenure of 3 years

in the concerned allotted Revenue Division. Rule 15 envisages strict compliance by the concerned authorities of the aforesaid Rules of 21.

5. Learned counsel submitted that having regard to the rules as aforesaid, it was open for the respondents to transfer the applicant at any other place in the Aurangabad Revenue Division, if at all for certain reasons they were not willing to retain the applicant at Aurangabad. Learned counsel submitted that daughter of the applicant who is 18 years old is suffering from Cerebral palsy and is under treatment at Aurangabad. Learned counsel submitted that her treatment will be discontinued and may have adverse affect on her, if the applicant mid-term transferred that too at faraway distance at Sindhudurg. Learned counsel submitted that the applicant has not yet been relieved from his existing post and no other officer yet been appointed in his place. Learned counsel in the circumstances has prayed for temporarily staying the effect and operation of the impugned order of transfer at least till the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents.

- Learned Presenting Officer has sought time to 6. seek instructions in the matter. Learned P.O. submitted that without authentic instructions in the matter, it may not be possible for him to make any submission on the correctness of the facts stated by the applicant in his Original Application. Learned P.O., however, opposed for grant of interim relief as has been sought by the applicant. Learned P.O. submitted that when from the impugned order it is quite evident that the applicant has been transferred invoking provisions under Section 4(4) and 4(5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (in short "the Transfer Act 2005"), unless the reasons are brought on record by the respondents, it may be unjust to pass any order even any interim order in favour of the applicant. Learned P.O. submitted that within two weeks, affidavit in reply will be filed and will be placed on record with all the relevant documents.
- 7. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, respondent authorities. I have also perused the documents

filed on record. It is not in dispute that the applicant has not completed his ordinary tenure on the existing post. It is thus evident that he has been transferred mid-term and mid-tenure. The respondents seem to have invoked the powers under Section 4(4) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act, 2005. In the order of transfer it is not expected to record the elaborate reasons. Such reasons can be brought on record and brought to the notice of the Tribunal from the contemporary record. In the present matter however having regard to the fact that no one has been yet posted in place of the applicant and he has not yet been relieved and further that he has been transferred out of Aurangabad Division, primafacie case is made out by the applicant for temporarily protecting his interest till the affidavit in reply is filed by the respondents. No grave prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondents, if the respondents are directed to allow the applicant to discharge his duties on the existing post. clarified that if it is the case of the respondents that will be prejudicial to the interest of the respondents to continue the applicant on the present post, it would be open for the respondents

to come out with the case accordingly which can be considered by this Tribunal. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 17.08.2023, till then the respondents shall temporarily allow the applicant to discharge his duties on the existing post. It would be open for the respondents to move the matter even on earlier date, if such contingency is there as observed in the body of the order above.
- (ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- (iii) Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- (iv) This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- (v) The service may be done by hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgment be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry before due date. Applicant is directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.
