- (d) Applicants have not completed two tenures. Since applicants transfer were ordered before completion of two tenures. Mandatory requirement for transfer as prescribed in Section 3 of R.O.T. Act, 2005 have to be followed, however, those are not complied with.

- (e) Various provisions such as Sections 22(J)-3, 22(J)-4 and 22(N)(e) have not been followed.
- 4. The foundation on which present O.A. is opposed as seen in the affidavit-in-reply of the Respondents, it is seen that Respondents are proceeding on the following foundation:-

Section 22(N) of the Bombay Police Act, 1951 prescribes tenure of police personnel but does not lay down / fixed tenure for other employees than police personnel. Therefore, impugned transfers are legal and proper.

5. On the contrary applicants' averment seen in paragraph 6.9 of O.A.No.469 /2015 is that applicant would be governed by the R.O.T. Act, 2005. Relevant averment is quoted below for ready reference:-

"Therefore, under the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, if no fix tenure is mentioned in the ordinance dt. 16th Feb. 2015, under the Bombay Police Act, 1951 then in that circumstances of the case, the transfer Act, is made applicable in the facts of this case and the applicant is eligible for transfer under the Transfer Act 2005, as stated out at A and B of the original application by the applicant herein the case.
