He refers to para 10 of the judgment and order dated 6.12.2019 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in CA No.9140/2019 Rajesh Kumar Dwivedi Vs. State of U.P. & Anr. which reads as under:

- By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, the Original Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Bench under the caption "for Dismissal" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original Application shall stand dismissed.
