2. Vide order dated 07.12.2023 the Registrar of this Tribunal was pleased to refuse the registration of M.A. & O.A. under Rule 5 (4) of Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedural) Rules, 1988. On 26.10.2023 the office has raised the following office objections in O.A. St. No. 2130/2023:-

1. Pagination on list of documents not properly mentioned; and
2. Page No. 47 to 50,76,163,170 to 175 not readable.

3. Vide office note dated 30.11.2023 Registrar of this Tribunal at Aurangabad Bench noted that nobody appeared for the applicant and office objections are not removed.

4. The learned Advocate for the applicant appeared today. He undertakes to remove the office objections within reasonable period.

5. Technically, the Registrar was right in refusing the registration since nobody appeared for the applicant in

view of the objections in spite of repeated chances. The fact that the M.A. is filed for condonation of delay caused in O.A. St. No. 2130/2023 and O.A. is filed with a prayer to quash and set aside the order dated 04.10.2018 passed by respondent No. 1, so also the impugned order dated 10.10.2019 passed by respondent No. 2 and further seeking directions to respondent Nos. 1, 2, 4 to 7 to treat the suspension period of the applicant from 09.03.2012 to 15.05.2013 as 'on duty period' by regularizing the same and release the difference salary of the applicant by granting annual increments of 2012 and 2013 to the applicant and in order to give an opportunity to the applicant to prove his claim on merits, it will be in the interest of justice to allow the appeal as the applicant shall not suffer for the negligence of his Advocate. Hence, the following order:-

**ORDER**

- (i) Chamber Appeal No. 29/2023 is allowed as the applicant undertakes to remove the office objection within a reasonable period.
- (ii) Registrar of this Tribunal Bench at Aurangabad is directed to register the M.A. & O.A. after removing the office objections by the learned Advocate for the
