Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.</li> <li>2. Learned P.O. filed 'Short Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 03.01.2024 on behalf of Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial) Thane. It is taken on record. The 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 03.01.2024 mentions that the total 'Sanctioned Posts' of 'Forest Guards' in 'Shahapur Forest Division' is 182. The number of 'Forest Guards' working at present in 'Shahapur Forest Division' are 152.</li> <li>3. Learned PO then referred to G.R. G.A.D. dated 01.02.2023 to states that 50% posts of 'Forest Guards' are reserved for 'Schedule Tribes' category; while remaining 50% posts of Forest Guards are for category of 'Non Schedule Tribes'. Accordingly; the number of posts of 'Forest Guards' reserved for 'Schedule Tribes' category would be 91 and number of posts of 'Forest Guard' available for 'Non Schedule Tribes' would also be 91. However, at present 125 'Forest Guards' from category of 'Non Schedule Tribes' are working in 'Shahapur Forest Division' against earmarked posts of 91 'Forest Guards'.</li> <li>4. The 'Chief Conservator of Forest (Territorial), Thane' in 'Affidavit-in-Reply' dated 03.01.2024 has referred to the G.R. of G.A.D. dated 01.02.2023 which is about appointment of 'Government Servants' by 'Direct Recruitment' with reference to implementation of 'PESA ACT, 1996'. The subject is now 'Subjudice' before the 'Hon'ble Supreme Court of India'. The G.A.D. G.R. dated 01.02.2023 does make any reference to implementation of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' vis-à-vis 'PESA ACT, 1996'. Further unlike G.A.D. letters dated 13.12.2023 and 17.12.2023 by which all 'Administrative Departments' were directed to not take any action to make appointments of 'Government Servants' by 'Direct</li> </ol>

	<p>Recruitment' in areas under 'PESA ACT, 1996', no such specific instructions, have been issued by G.A.D. to all Administrative Departments to keep in abeyance implementation of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005' in respect of 50% posts reserved for 'Schedule Tribes' category which are located in areas under 'PESA ACT, 1996'.</p> <p>5. The Affidavit-in-Reply of 'Chief of Conservator of forests (Territorial), Thane' dated 03.01.2024 also mentions about there being 30 'Vacant Posts' of 'Forest Guards' in 'Shahapur Forest Division'. Thus; evidently against 91 'Forest Guards' from category of 'Non Schedule Tribes' there are additional 34 'Forest Guard' who are from 'Non Schedule Tribes' category and presently serving in 'Shahapur Forest Division'. Hence against the facts and circumstances stated above and as no specific directions have been issued by G.A.D. not to post 'Government Servants' on vacant posts which may be located in areas under 'PESA ACT, 1996'; it is necessary to modify directions in 'Para' 6 given 12.12.2023 to 'Chief Conservator of Forest, Thane'.</p> <p>6. The 'Chief Conservator of Forest, Thane' Thane is thus directed to seek 10 options afresh from all Applicants after disclosure of information about location of 'Vacant Posts' of 'Forest Guards' even if those are amongst 50% posts for category of 'Schedule Tribes' and located in areas under 'PESA ACT, 1996'. The Applicant's 10 options be then considered and they be transferred as per provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.</p> <p>7. The 'Chief Conservator of Forests (Territorial), Thane' to take appropriate decision to transfer the Applicants on any of the 30 'Vacant Posts' of 'Forest Guards' in 'Shahapur Forest Division' within next 'Four Weeks'.</p> <p>8. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents</p> <p>2. The Applicant has filed Application Form pursuant to Advertisement No.045/2022, dated 11.05.2022 issued by MPSC for 'State Services Preliminary Examination, 2022'. The Applicant contends that he has cleared 'Preliminary Examination' and 'Main Examination'. He has applied under "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016" for category of persons with disability who have 4% reservation under Section 34 (d).</p> <p>3. There were 8 posts reserved for those with autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness as per Advertisement No.99/2022, dated 11.05.2022 issued by MPSC. The Applicant submits that his name is not included in the list of 'Selected Candidates' for 'Interview' and he may be allowed to appear for 'Interview'.</p> <p>4. Learned CPO submits that 'Disability Certificate' dated 21/01/2022 of the Applicant was issued by 'Government B.J. Medical College and Sassoon General Hospital Pune'. Learned CPO further states that though the Applicant is having 40% disability, it is 'Temporary Disability' as recoded in his 'Disability Certificate', dated 21.01.2022 which is valid for 5 years i.e. from 21.01.2022 to 21.01.2027. She further submits that as per Social Justice Department's G.R. dated 13.09.2022 the disability should be 'Permanent Disability'. However, disability of Applicant has been certified for period of 5 years. The Applicant therefore is not entitled to get benefit of 'Mental Illness' which is not 'Permanent Disability' under 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016'.</p>

5. The main objection of the MPSC for not allowing the Applicant for 'Interview' is that Applicant is holding 'Disability Certificate' which is for temporary period i.e. from 21.01.2022 to 21.01.2027. The 'Section 34' of 'The Right of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' is about 'Reservation' where under Sub Section (d) - 'Mental Illness' is considered 'Benchmark' as one of the 'Disability for Reservation'. Sub Section (d) of Section 34 which is relevant here reads as under :-

*"34 : Every appropriate Government shall appoint every Government establishment not less than four per cent of the total number of vacancies in the cadre strength in each group of posts meant to be filled with persons with benchmark disabilities of which, one per cent. each shall be reserved for persons with Benchmark Disabilities under Clauses (a), (b) and (c) and 1 per cent. for persons with Benchmark Disabilities under Clauses (d) and (e), namely -*

*(d) autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.*

6. The extent of disability should be no less than 40% for persons with 'Benchmark Disability'. 'Section 2 (r)' of 'The Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016' defines a 'Person with Benchmark Disability' as under:-

*"2 (r) : Persons with benchmark disability" means a persons with no less than forty per cent of a specified disability where specified disability has not been defined in measurable terms and includes a person with disability where specified disability has been defined in measurable terms, as certified by the certifying authority."*

7. The word 'Temporary Disability' and 'permanent Disability' is nowhere defined separately in 'The Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016' or also in Rules. However, definition of a 'Person with Disability' is defined in Section 2(s) of 'The Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016' and reads as follows:-

*"2(s) : "persons with disability" means a persons with long term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairment which, inter-action with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others."*

8. The of period of disability being 'Long Term' is not to be measured in terms of years; but it is to be read in the context of later part of definition of Section 2(s) as *"which, inter-action with barriers, hinders his full and effective participation in society equally with others."*

9. The 'Disability Certificate' of the Applicant shows that he is suffering from "Recurrent Depressive Disorder". The 'Disability Certificate', dated 21.01.2022 which was issued by B. J. Medical College & Sassoon General Hospital, Pune is valid for 5 years. The Applicant has informed that he has been undergoing treatment with medication for 'Recurrent Depressive Disorder' since 2007.
