The names of Applicants were shown in the list of 'Disqualified Candidates' on the ground that as per 'Laboratory Assistant, Group-C (Technical) in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (Recruitment) Rules, 2020' & 'Laboratory Technician, Group-C (Technical) in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research

(Recruitment) Rules, 2020', they do not possess the 'Valid Certificate of Registration' issued by Maharashtra Paramedical Council'. Learned Counsel states Lic' Applicants have already produced the 'Receipt of Registration' and also produced 'Validity Certificate' issued by the Maharashtra Paramedical Council between November, 2023 to January, 2024 and those Certificates were accepted by Respondents.

5. Learned Counsel for Applicants placed reliance on Rule 3 of 'Laboratory Assistant, Group-C (Technical) in the Directorate of Medical Education and Research (Recruitment) Rules, 2020' in respect of appointment by nomination and eligibility required for the same.
