- The applicant seeks interim relief to send the applicant for Armourer Basic Training at Pune, which commences from 4.4.2022.
- Ld. PO relies on GR dated 26.10.1966 regarding sending persons to the Armourer's Training School, SRPF. Group-I, Pune. Ld. PO, on instructions from Shri T.M. Chaure, Police Inspector and Shri S.D. Thombre, Assistant Sub-Inspector, submits that after 2018 nobody other than Police Constable have been sent for training.
- Ld. Advocate for the applicant relies on the order dated 20.6.2018 passed by the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal in OA No.391 of 2018 (Shri Umesh A. Bundele Vs. State of Maharashtra & Ors.). In this case applicant voluntarily sought demotion to become qualified for the training and the matter was disposed off with a direction to the concerned respondent to consider the case of the applicant sympathetically for the next training program of Basic Armed Training Session Program No.48.
- The applicant from 2005 to 2012 was working as a Police Constable, which is the time he was eligible to go for training. However, he does not raise any objection when he was not sent. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that on the ground of parity the applicant should be sent for training as in the past Naik and Assistant Sub-Inspectors have been sent for this training.
- Ld. PO, on instructions, states that no Assistant Sub-Inspector has been sent for this training till today and they

have stopped sending other than Police Constable for training.

7. However, we feel that the applicant is not eligible for the said training in view of GR dated 26.10.1966. The preamble of the said GR reads as under:

"An Armourer School was started at the SRPF Gr.1, Poona in June 1963 with the object of training a sufficient number of Police Constables in the repairs and maintenance of Arms at the initial stage and subsequently to hold Refresher Courses and Courses for the training of new recruits. The first phase of the training has been completed and since April 1965, Refresher Courses had been started at the School. In this connection, attention is invited to GRs. HD, No.TEX-1962/43338-V dated 24.5.1963 and No.TEX-1962/43338-V dated 31.3.1965."

- 8. Though in the GR the wording "Arourer's Training to Policemen w.e.f. 1.11.1966" is mentioned but it has to be read in context with the preamble of the said GR which restricts to training of Police Constable only. Hence, the prayer for interim relief is rejected.
