ORDER

- 1. Heard Shri R. Sorankar, the learned Advocate for the Applicant, Ms. S. Suryawanshi, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents 1 & 2 and Shri M.R. Patil, the learned Advocate for the Respondent No.4.
- 2. At the outset, Learned advocate for the applicant states that he withdraws the allegations of unfair conduct attributed by him against learned P.O Ms Savita Suryavanshi, contained in additional affidavit dated 25.4.2018 and affidavit in rejoinder dated 2.5.2018.
- 3. The O.A. was taken up for final hearing and was heard for considerable time.
- 4. Today is last working day before vacation. Though we had commenced the hearing for final disposal, it is not possible to complete it.
- 5. Therefore, we have heard parties on interim relief.
- 6. In the light of facts which have surfaced during the hearing, applicant deserves opportunity of access to the record for inspection and even for supply of copies.



- 7. Certain facts have transpired during the hearing, which are as follows:-
 - (a) There existed one vacancy.
 - (b) As per the procedure Rules, 5 eligible candidates are required to be called for the interview.
 - (c) Bench-mark was fixed before verification of actual eligibility, barely on candidates' representation.
 - (d) 5 candidates based on their representations as to their eligibility were called for verification of documents, and also for interview, based on their representation as to eligibility.
 - (e) After the process of verification of credentials was done, only three candidates were found to possess the eligibility for interview.
 - (f) All other candidates' candidature was declined, and only three candidates were interviewed.
- 8. According to the Applicant, the ratio of vacancies to candidates is to be 1:5 is consciously violated. This mandatory requirement is not disputed by the Applicant.
- 9. It is shown by M.P.S.C. that candidates were called for verification of documents by observing ratio of 1:5. However, the ratio has fallen to 1:3 for interviews, though eligibility of few other candidates was not examined due to prematurely fixed benchmark.
- 10. The act of M.P.S.C. is done in conscious breach of the rule and not an eventuality which has occurred despite diligence on the part of M.P.S.C..
- 11. Thus it is evident that M.P.S.C. has run the risk of inviting the candidates less in number for verification, that resulting in breach of said ratio for interview.
- 12. Admittedly the bench-mark is always ascertained on the basis of availability of number of eligible candidates arranged in order of merit as prescribed and as assessed by M.P.S.C.. M.P.S.C. could have called large number of candidates for verification of credential, thereafter fixed the Bench-mark after listing all the eligible candidates upon verification, allowed candidates according to merit and ratio of 1:5 for interview.

- 13. Thus the identification of Bench-mark itself was done in grave erroneous manners.
- 14. Hence, Applicant has made out the case to show that M.P.S.C has not just erred but has committed the illegality, knowing well fully consequences of its act.
- 15. It is not shown that any compelling circumstances existed due to which number of candidates of required magnitude were not called for verification of credentials.
- 16. The eligibility committed by the M.P.S.C. goes to the root of the case.
- 17. Learned Advocate further prays that in the background of facts what has transpired is that Applicant is entitled for receiving inspection of copies of documents and will have to amend the O.A. and prays for leave.
- 18. In view of the foregoing observations, following order is passed :-
 - (a) M.P.S.C. is directed to provide to the Applicant's advocate inspection of original record of M.P.S.C regarding scrutiny, arrival at bench mark etc.
 - (b) M.P.S.C. is directed to furnish to the Applicant copies of documents as may be asked for.
 - (c) Applicant is granted leave to amend by way of substitution of paper book of O.A upon accepting Applicant's undertaking to carry out the amendment on or before 30.05.2018.
 - (d) Applicant shall serve the paper book of amended O.A. on the Respondents.
 - (e) Upon substitution affidavits filed by the parties including rejoinder be stuck off and removed from the first part of the court record. If the amendment is not carried out before date O.A. shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Applicant.
 - (f) M.P.S.C. is restrained by injunction from deciaring the results to process of selection.
 - (g) It is clarified that if M.P.S.C. chooses it may call additional candidates for verification of credential of the candidates for securing required number of candidates for interview, re-fix the bench-mark and proceed to hold interview afresh without any express leave of this Tribunal.
