3. The Special Counsel for the State mentions about the decision by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.11443 of 2016 and Others, dated 23.04.2018. The Hon'ble High Court has requested the M.A.T. to decide the matter expeditiously.
4. Smt. Ranjana Todankar, learned Advocate mentions that she is representing in O.A. No.467/2015 and Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate mentions that he does not have any instructions from any of his petitioners.
5. In the above circumstances, learned Special Counsel for the State is directed to inform the Head of each institution where the petitioners are working and intimate them about the decision of the Hon'ble High Court as well as next date of hearing in the Tribunal of M.A.T. and obtain receipt from the petitioners. The Head of the institute should obtain the acknowledgment from the concerned petitioners, if, they are functioning in the same place.
6. Special Counsel for the State also underlines that since the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court is judgment in rem, the petitioners are supposed to be aware. The above arrangement is by abundant precaution to intimate them and will not be considered as binding on each and every petitioners interested in this matter.
7. The matter is adjourned for final hearing on 20.06.2018.
