 - (iv) The cancellation order was stayed.

- (vii) By impugned order the applicant is transferred to Nanded Circle.
- 9. Ld. PO was called to state as to whether the file in which the decision to transfer the applicant is brought. Ld. PO has answered in the affirmative and tendered file for perusal.
- 10. On perusal it has transpired that proposal for applicant's transfer was initiated because of the complaint submitted to Director General of Police (DG) by Shri Sanjay Vishwanath Begde, Hon'ble Member of Legislative Assembly which is dated 9.11.2015.
- 11. The matter was again placed before the Police Establishment Board (PEB) concerned by circulation and approval has been obtained. The file does not disclose that the facts leading to the contents of complaint were investigated, ascertained or enquired into.
