- 1. Shri N.S. Satpute, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. A.B. Kololgi, learned Presenting Officer for Respondents is present.
- 2. These M.As are filed for condonation of delay and restoration of O.A. dismissed for default on 17.03.2023.
- 3. The perusal of record reveals that when the matter was called for hearing on 17.03.2023, the Applicant and Advocate were absent, and therefore, O.A. was dismissed for default. The Tribunal also observed that earlier also, O.A. was dismissed for default, but it was restored in view of order passed in M.A.583/2022. Despite restoration of O.A, the Applicant and his Advocate were absent, and therefore, it came to be dismissed for default.
- 4. As such, this is second M.A. for restoration of O.A. along with application for condonation of delay.
- 5. The learned Advocate for the Applicant submits that he was not feeling well and was advised to take rest from 15.03.2023 to 17.03.2023, and therefore, could not remain present before the Tribunal. He has further pointed out Leave Note to that effect filed by him before Registrar, High Court, Bombay.
- 6. In view of above, in the interest of justice, I am inclined to re-call the order of dismissal and to restore O.A. so as to decide the same on merit, but it should be subject to payment of cost of Rs.2,000/- payable within two weeks from today.
- 7. If the cost is paid within two weeks, O.A. be listed for final hearing.
