Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that Higher and Technical Education Department G.R. dated 18.02.2021 which is applicable to posts under the "Directorate of Higher Education" allows candidates with 'Low Vision (LV)' to apply for appointment to the post of 'Assistant Professors in institutions such as Government Science, Arts, Commerce Colleges.' However, Higher and Technical Education Department by G.R. dated 22.02.2021 which is applicable to posts under the "Directorate of Technical Education" does not allow candidates like the Applicant with 'Low Vision (LV)' to apply for appointment to post of 'Assistant Professor in institutions such as Government Engineering Colleges' so as to enable them to teach Science Subjects such as 'Chemistry'.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that there has to be parity in 'Policy Decision' taken by the Higher and Technical Education Department in respect of the 'Directorate of Higher Education' and "Directorate of Technical Education" and even between the State Government and Central Government for implementation of the provisions of Section 33(1) of 'The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' and specifically as such decision in respect of candidates with 'Low Vision' (LV) has already been taken by Central Government vide Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Notification dated 4th January, 2021 which has also been referred to in Social Justice and Special Assistance Department GR of 02.02.2021 issued by State Government.</p>

4. The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 under 'Section 33(1)' gives full authority to the 'Appropriate Government' defined under Section 2(b)(ii) for 'Identification of Posts' under 'Section 33(1)' which can be held by respective categories of persons with "Benchmark Disabilities" in respect of the vacancies reserved in accordance with the provisions of 'Section 34'.

5. The Higher and Technical Education Department has carried out this exercise as per 'Section 33(1)' of the 'The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' and thereafter issued G.Rs. on 18.02.2021 and 22.02.2021. Therefore the prayer for 'Interim Relief' of the Applicant that as he is afflicted by 'Low Visions (LV)' and as per Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Notification dated 4th January, 2021 he is eligible to be appointed ^{So} he be allowed to apply and appear for examination to be conducted by MPSC as per Advertisement No.048/2023 issued on 01.09.2023 for the post of Assistant Professor to teach 'Chemistry' in 'Government Engineering Colleges.' The grant of 'Interim Relief' to Applicant cannot be considered as there is stage, as no such post has been brought under reservation under Section 33(1) read with Section 34 by G.R. of Higher and Technical Education Department dated 22.02.2021. However given the facts and circumstances of the case, it will not be out of context to mention that 'The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' defines under (i) "Section 2(h) – Discrimination" (ii) "Section 2 (y) – Reasonable Accommodation". Further, because 'Section 3 (5)' directs that 'Appropriate Government' as defined in 'Section 2(b)(ii)' shall take necessary steps to ensure "Reasonable Accommodation" for the person with disabilities. Learned CPO to take instructions of the Higher and Technical Education Department as to whether they willing to consider the case of the Applicant as per provisions of 'Section 2(h)' read with 'Section 2(y)' and Section 3(5) of the "The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and allow the Applicant to apply for post of Assistant Professor to teach 'Chemistry' in 'Government Engineering Colleges' for which Advertisement No.048/2023 has been issued by MPSC on 01.09.2023.
