- there has to be parity in 'Policy Decision' taken by the Higher and Technical Education Department in respect of the 'Directorate of Higher Education' and "Directorate of Technical Education' and even between the State Government and Central Government for implementation of the provisions of Section 33(1) of 'The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016' and specifically as such decision in respect of candidates with 'Low Vision' (LV) has already been taken by Central Government vide Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment Notification dated 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2021 which has also been referred to in Social Justice and Special Assistance Department GR of 02.02.2021 issued by State Government.

Further, because 'Section 3 (5)' directs that 'Appropriate Government' as defined in 'Section 2(b)(ii)' shall take necessary steps to ensure "Reasonable Accommodation" for the person with disabilities. Learned CPO to take instructions of the Higher and Technical Education Department as to whether they willing to consider the case of the Applicant as per provisions of 'Section 2(h)' read with 'Section 2(y)' and Section 3(5) of the "The Right to Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and allow the Applicant to apply for post of Assistant Professor to teach 'Chemistry' in Government Engineering Colleges for which Advertisement No.048/2023 has been issued by MPSC on 01.09.2023.

The provision of Para 4.5 of G.R. of Public Health Department refers to grant of 'NOC' to 'In Service Candidates' to appear for NEET-PG:2023 and directs the Deputy Director of Health Services not to grant NOC, if there are any Departmental Enquiry or Criminal Case pending against any 'In Service Candidate'. The pendency of Departmental Enquiry or Criminal Case has to be before the Date of Issue of 'NOC' by the concerned Deputy Director of Health Services. Learned C.P.
