The Applicant permitted to forthwith join back on the post of 'Chief Officer, Talegaon - Dabhade Municipal Council, District Pune'.

8. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.



Learned Advocate for the Applicant produces letter of 'Revenue and Forest Department' dated 01.12.2023 regarding specific instructions to 'Divisional Commissioners' about prevalent practices in the offices of 'District Collectors', 'Sub Divisional Officers' and 'Tahsildars' of temporarily attaching services of employees in Class III including 'Circle Officers' and 'Talathis' as in case of the Applicants.

3. The 'District Collector, Pune' was already given directions to issue appropriate orders to (i) 'S.D.O, Pune, District Pune' to forthwith withdraw 'Memorandum' dated 01.10.2023 and (ii) 'Tahsildar Shirur, District Pune' to withdraw Order dated 01.10.2023 to temporarily attach services of the Applicants who belong to cadre of 'Talathi'; because *prima-facie* these have been issued in contravention of provisions of 'Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005'.
