Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant was posted on establishment of 'Superintendent of Police (Rural), Pune' on 27.02.2021. The Applicant has now been transferred from post of 'Police Inspector' in 'Security Branch' by order dated 24.02.2024 of 'Special I.G.P., Kolhapur Range' on grounds of completion of '3' years in last '4' years in 'Pune District' in accordance with directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.</p> <p>3. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that prior to being posted on establishment of 'Superintendent of Police (Rural), Pune' the Applicant had served as 'A.P.I.' on establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri - Chinchwad' from 01.07.2020 to 28.02.2021. Thereafter, the Applicant went on promotion as 'Police Inspector' to 'C.I.D. Jalgaon' where he served from 15.05.2021 to 03.09.2021. Thus there was break in his service period within 'Pune District'. Hence tenure at 'C.I.D. Jalgaon' from 15.05.2021 to 03.09.2021 was not to have been counted in '3' Years in last '4' Years within 'Pune District'; as per directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.</p> <p>4. Learned P.O. to therefore inform 'Special I.G.P., Kolhapur Range' to forthwith reconcile the length of all tenures of Applicant within 'Pune District' and inform</p>

as to whether he had completed '3' years in last '4' years in 'Pune District' as per directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. Till such time the Applicant is permitted to continue on post of 'Police Inspector' in 'Security Branch' on establishment of 'S.P. (Rural), Pune'. Further 'Special I.G.P., Kolhapur Range' to keep 'One Post' of 'Police Inspector' vacant till such time on establishment of 'S.P. (Rural), Pune'.

5. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.

1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, Shri M.D. Lonkar, Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, Shri K.B. Jadhav, learned Advocate holding for Shri R.G. Panchal, learned Advocates for the Applicants. Shri A.J. Chougule, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents in 'Group - I', Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents in 'Group - II', Smt. 2. Heard Shri Pradeep Rajgopal, learned Sr. Advocate for 'E.C.I' on behalf of 'Additional Chief Secretary' & 'Chief Election Officer, Maharashtra State'.

3. Learned Sr. Advocate for 'E.C.I' on behalf of 'Additional Chief Secretary' & 'Chief Election Officer, Maharashtra State' presents 'Tabular Chart' prepared by the Additional Chief Secretary and Chief Electoral Officer Maharashtra State as per directions in 'Para 8' of Order dated 27.02.2024 so as to summarize outcomes achieved following review meeting held on 20.02.2024 with 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' and 'Commissioner of Police' Establishment' viz 'Director General of Police, along with 'Commissioners of Police - Pimpri-Chinchwad; Pune, Thane & Nashik', and 'Superintendent of Police-Satara' & 'Solapur'.

4. Learned Sr. Advocate for 'E.C.I' on behalf of 'Additional Chief Secretary' & 'Chief Election Officer, Maharashtra State' relying on 'Tabular Chart' states that in respect of 'Police Inspectors' total of 226 'Transfer Orders' were review out of which (i) 105 'Transfer Orders' are to be 'Modified/Changed' (ii) 56 'Transfer Orders' are not required to be 'Modified/Changed' (iii) 65 'Transfer Orders' which are of 'Functional Posts' and 'Other Criteria' are given 'No Remarks'.

5. Learned PO thereupon refers to 'Para 7' of Order dated 27.02.2024 and submits copy of revised 'Transfer Order' dated 04.03.2024 of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State'

by which 65 'Police Inspector' have been reinstated on their earlier posts in 'Functional Departments' as per directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.

6. Learned Advocates of Applicants thereupon were heard to ascertain outcomes of revised 'Transfer Order' dated 04.03.2024 of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' with respect to redressal of grievances of Applicants following the review meeting held by 'Additional Chief Secretary and Chief Electoral Officer Maharashtra State'. The 'Additional Chief Secretary and Chief Electoral Officer Maharashtra State' after the review meeting had issued detailed instructions to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' on 22.02.2022 regarding stringent implementation of directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.

6.1 Learned Advocate for Applicants in O.A. No.124/2024, O.A. No.125/2024 & O.A. No.150/2024 thereupon stated that these 3 Applicants had been transferred from establishment of 'Commissioner of Police' 'Pimpri – Chinchwad' on grounds of 'Pune District' being their 'Home District'. However the reason for transfer is because 'Home Districts' have been wrongly recorded in their 'Service Books' which have still not been corrected although representations have been submitted by Applicants to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.

6.2. Learned Advocate for Applicant thereafter states that 5 Applicants in 'O.A. No.151/2024, O.A. No.152/2024, O.A. No.127/2024, O.A. No.155/2024, O.A. No.153/2024' have been transferred on grounds as 'Home District' and / or completion of tenure of '3' Years out of '4' Years in 'Pune District' but their request for retention in 'Pune District' was purely on 'Compassionate Grounds' such as (i) Ailments of Spouse & Family Members & (ii) Short Time left for Retirement.

6.3 Learned Advocate for Applicant in O.A. No. 129/2024 stated that Applicants has been retained in his earlier place of posting in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Thane' by Order dated 04.03.2024 of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State'.

6.4 Learned Advocate for Applicant in O.A. 161/2024 states that Applicant does not want to pursue further with redressal of grievance and now wants to join

on post of 'Police Inspector' in establishment of 'Commissioner of Police, Nagpur' as per 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' Order dated 30.01.2024.

6.5. Learned Advocate for Applicant in O.A. 135/2024 & O.A. No.136/2024 also states that Applicants do not want to persue further with their redressal of grievance and have now joined on posts 'Police Inspectors' as per Order dated 24.01.2024 of 'Commissioner of Police, Pune'.

7. Learned Advocates for Applicants thereafter were informed to peruse the 'Tabular Charts' submitted by 'Additional Chief Secretary and Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' and correlate them to revised 'Transfer Order' dated 04.03.2024 of 'D.G.P., Maharashtra State' so as to by 'Next Date' confirm in which of the O.A.'s out of 'Group-I' to 'Group-III'; grievances of Applicants have been redressed and therefore those O.As can be disposed off. The O.A's which were quickly identified although tentatively for disposal on 'Next Date' are 'O.A. No.114/2024, O.A. No.122/2024, O.A. No.126/2024, O.A. No.127/2024, O.A. No.129/2024, O.A. No.144/2024, O.A. No.145/2024, O.A. No.146/2024, O.A. No.147/2024, O.A. No.123/2024, O.A. No.148/2024, O.A. No.194/2024, O.A. No.149/2024, O.A. No.161/2024, O.A. No.135/2024 and O.A. No.136/2024'.

8. Learned P.O. to seek 'Additional Information' about subsisting grievance of Applicants in O.A. No. 124/2024, O.A. No.125/2024 & O.A. No.150/2024 relating to corrections of entries in 'Service Records' relating to 'Home District' and in respect of Applicants in 'O.A. No.151/2024, O.A. No.152/2024, O.A. No.127/2024, O.A. No.155/2024, O.A. No.153/2024' which relate to consideration of their requests for retention in 'Pune District' on 'Compassionate Grounds', so that these can be accordingly heard based on 'Additional Information' received from 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.

9. 'Interim Relief' thus be continued only in respect of 8 O.As mentioned in 'Para 8' till 'Additional Information' received from 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' is considered on the 'Next Date'.

Thus, no 'Interim Relief' was granted to Applicant No.2 - Dr. Smita Parkhe. She is already retired on 31st May, 2023 and therefore, any further consequential order is issued, it may not be given effect.</p> <p>5. The learned CPO confirms the submissions made by learned Advocate for Applicants.</p> <p>6. 7. The learned Advocate for Applicants submits that though Applicant No.2 – Dr. Smita Parkhe was allowed to withdraw OA on 06.02.2024 by this Tribunal and she has not sought any 'Interim Relief' from this Tribunal, she stood retired on 31.01.2023. However, as this fact was not mentioned in order dated 06.02.2024 and matter is fixed today interregnum, the Department passed order on 01.03.2024 of her reinstatement to her previous post and she is directed to join forthwith. The learned Advocate for Applicants submits that the order of reinstatement was passed in view of interim protection and order passed by this Tribunal in OA 1406/2023.

8. On the above background of the submissions made by learned Advocate for Applicants, it is necessary to clear that Applicant No.2 – Dr. Smita Parkhe has withdrawn from OA No.1406/2023 and no 'Interim Relief' was granted to her protecting her service after her retirement i.e. on 31.05.2023. Thus, Applicant No.2 – Dr. Smita Parkhe stood retired on 31.05.2023. She was not a beneficiary of 'Interim Order' passed by this Tribunal on 06.02.2024, as she was not prosecuting any matter before us on that day. Therefore, if order dated 01.03.2024 passed by Government based on 'Interim Relief' granted by this Tribunal in OA No.1406/2023, it is in fact not made applicable to Dr. Smita Parkhe.

9. We request learned CPO to communicate this order to Respondent-Department about withdrawal of order of reinstatement of Applicant No. 2 - Dr. Smita Parkhe.
