The applicant has filed the present Original Application challenging the order of recovery directed to be made from the retiral benefits of the applicant on account of excess payment made to the applicant during the period between 2015 and 2022. The recovery is for the amount more than Rs. 7 lacks. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant retired in the year 2022 on attaining the age of superannuation. At the relevant time neither the Departmental Enquiry nor any Judicial Proceeding was pending against the applicant. It is further submits that while retiring the applicant nothing was whispered about the excess payment made to the applicant and after one year of her retirement, now recovery is sought. Learned counsel in the circumstances, while praying for issuing the notices to the respondents, has also prayed for interim relief thereby staying the effect and operation of the impugned order to the extent of recovery.

3. I have gone through the impugned order and other documents filed on record. The applicant has certainly made out a *prima facie* case for grant of interim relief. In the circumstances, the following order is passed.

ORDER

- (i) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 14.06.2023. Till then the execution and implementation of the order impugned in the present O.A. dated 16.2.2023 shall stand stayed to the extent of recovery.
- (ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

When the present matter is taken up for 2. consideration and after I heard learned counsel appearing for the applicant, as well as, learned Presenting Officer for some time, it is revealed that the applicant had previously filed a complaint (ULP No. 297/1997) before the learned Industrial Court. Learned Industrial Court vide its judgment and order passed on 29.9.2004 allowed the said complaint, thereby directing the respondents to grant permanency to the present applicant in the post of Nurse with all the benefits attached to the said post from the date of order. It is also revealed that the State Government though filed the Writ Petition before the Hon'ble High Court challenging the aforesaid decision of the learned Industrial Court and though the Hon'ble High Court had issued rule in the matter, has not granted the interim stay. In the circumstances, the applicant has been continued in

service and time to time the orders have been issued in favour of the applicant subject to the decision of the Hon'ble High Court in the pending Writ Petition. In the meanwhile it appears that the Government took a decision in respect of the staff nurses alike present applicant to regularize them. The Government decided to regularize the services of such nurses by requiring them to appear for one written examination and staff nurses who passed the said examination have been considered for the benefit of regularization.

3. It is the contention of the applicant in the present O.A. that several such staff nurses have been extended such benefit from the date of their initial appointment. In the present matter the applicant has filed on record the letter dated 4.12.2017 under the signature of District Civil Surgeon, Ahmednagar, whereby he has directed the Sub District Hospital and Rural Hospitals to submit the proposals of such staff nurses working in the respective offices with certain documents for the purpose of regularizing their services. It is the contention of the applicant in the present O.A. that accordingly after having scrutinized the documents submitted by the applicant though she has been regularized, the date of regularization is shown "15.4.2015", the present OA is filed seeking direction against the respondents to

regularize the services of the applicant from the date of her initial appointment and not from 15.4.2015.

- 4. After having heard the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the applicant and thereafter reply to it by the learned Presenting Officer, it appears to me that in view of the pendency of the Writ Petition filed by the present respondents in the Hon'ble High Court, wherein rule has been granted but no interim relief has been granted, it may not be appropriate for this Tribunal to take up the matter having same prayers. Learned Presenting Officer invited my attention to the orders, which are placed on record to show that every order has been issued giving further appointment to the applicant mentioning therein that it is subject to the decision of the Writ Petition pending before the Hon'ble High Court.
- 5. In the aforesaid circumstances, it appears to me that it would be inappropriate for this Tribunal to take up matter and pass certain orders when the Writ Petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court involving same issue, wherein, as I noted earlier, rule has been granted. It appears to me that, whatever has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant before this Tribunal can also be submitted by him before the Hon'ble High Court in the aforesaid pending Writ Petition, may be by filing Civil Application in that regard bringing to the

notice of the Hon'ble High Court the subsequent developments in the matter and praying for decision in the said W.P. in view of the subsequent developments and the regularization orders passed by the respondents on the basis of the policy decision taken by them.

Heard Shri Avinash Khedkar, learned counsel holding for Shri S.S. Gangakhedkar, learned counsel for the applicant, Shri B.S. Deokar, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities and Shri N.S. Kadam, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3, 4 & 5.

- 2. The applicant has preferred the present Original Application seeking the following relief:-
 - "B) By allowing this Original Application, kindly quash and set-aside the impugned order/communication dated 08.02.2022 issued by the respondent No. 5 being arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the settled provisions of Law and consequently the direct the respondent authorities to refund the amount deducted from the salary of the applicant."
- 3. It is the case of the applicant that the officer concerned, who has issued the impugned order dated 08.02.2022 was not competent to issue such orders. Learned counsel for the applicant has

submitted that the order passed by the officer not having authority and jurisdiction to pass such order has to be held *non est* and cannot be acted upon. The applicant has, therefore, prayed for setting aside the said order.

4. The respondents have filed the affidavit in reply and have opposed the contentions raised in the O.A. After having gone through the pleadings of the parties and after having heard learned counsel for the parties, the following facts are revealed.

That the applicant is alleged to have obtained the salary for the period between 1.12.2019 and 6.8.2020 unauthorizedly though in the entire said period he did not attend the duties.

5. During the course of the arguments, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3 to 5 pointed out that the applicant himself has admitted that he has unauthorizedly received the salary of the said period and has also undertaken for refund of the said amount in installments. Such letter and the bond allegedly executed by the applicant are produced on record by the respondents. The same are brought to my notice.

- 6. From the pleadings and the arguments advanced, it is also revealed that the departmental enquiry has been initiated against the applicant, as well as, one Shri Ajay Shivankar. The charge against the applicant is that though he remained absent in the period between 1.12.2019 and 6.8.2020, he withdrew the salary of the aforesaid period to which he was not entitled. Shri Shivankar is charged with the misconduct that without verifying the facts he disbursed the amount of salary in favour of the applicant.
- 7. Having regard to the facts as aforesaid, no effective decision can be taken, in respect of the prayers made in the present O.A. This Tribunal while passing interim order on 31.03.2022 has protected the interest of the applicant, thereby staying recovery against him. If the recovery is to be made on the ground that the applicant withdrew the salary of the period in which he has not worked, unless the said charge is proved, the right of recovery may not accrue in favour of the respondents. Similarly if it is the contention of the applicant that the order is issued by the authority,

who is not competent, even that aspect can be considered by the enquiry officer. Prima facie, the contention of the applicant cannot be accepted for the reason that the order of recovery is not passed by the officer, who has issued the communication impugned in the present O.A. However, I will not make any more discussion in the issue, in view of the enquiry pending in the matter.

- 8. For the aforesaid reasons, it appears to me that the present O.A. can be disposed of by directing the respondents to complete the departmental enquiry against the applicant as expeditiously as possible and preferably within the period of six months from the date of this order, till then the effect and operation of the interim order passed by this Tribunal on 31.3.2022 shall continue to remain in force.
- 9. The Original Application stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms. There shall be no order as to costs.
