5. Learned P.O was called to tender para-wise remark for perusal. It is seen that para wise remarks are prepared by the office of D.G and submitted for approval to Addl. C.S, as well separate para-wise remarks are prepared by the Government.

6. It prima facie appears that the Respondents are treating the case as if the charge sheet is objected on the ground that it is served after retirement.

7. It appears that the Respondent have not at all approached to the case from the point of view that the charge sheet pertains to the period 4 years prior to retirement, and said aspect is not dealt with in para-wise remarks.

8. In this background it is hoped that specific response is given to para 7.7 and in particular to the objection that misconduct is prior to May 2012 while the charge sheet is dated 17.7.2017, i.e. more than 5 years.

9. Above observations are made in order to secure exact reply from the Respondents, in the light of evasive and sceptic para wise remarks.

10. Learned P.O prays for 3 weeks' time.

11. Though 3 weeks' time is prayed, five weeks' time is granted by way of last chance.
