

2. Ld. Advocate for respondent no.5 Shri U.V. Bhosle states that applicant has not made application for compassionate appointment. He relies on the clause 2(1)(d) of GR dated 10.11.2015 which states that person who is seeking job on heirship should be staying with the deceased. He states that respondent no.5 was staying with the deceased and he has submitted Aadhaar card whereas the applicant was not staying with the deceased which can be seen from the title of the OA. He also refers to clause 3 of the GR which states that application is to be submitted within one year of the expiry of the deceased person. The deceased has expired on 16.1.2021. Respondent No.5 has submitted application on 29.4.2021 whereas applicant has not submitted his application. He states that OA was filed in March, 2022. He had sufficient time to collect the record. Since the applicant does not have any case he is deliberately trying to delay and hence no further time should be granted.

3. Ld. Advocate for the applicants seeks two weeks time to file expert advise and take instructions whether to withdraw the matter. He states that the deceased was unmarried and neither respondent no.5 nor applicant are family members as per the MCS Rules.

4. Ld. Advocate for the applicant is granted time till 11.9.2023 for withdrawal failing which matter will be dismissed.
