Manchekar, learned C.P.O for the Respondents.</p> <p>2. The Applicant prays that this Tribunal be pleased to direct the Respondents to open the 'sealed cover' qua the Applicant in the meeting of the DPC held in December, 2021.</p> <p>3. The Ld. Advocate for the Applicant submits that the Applicant in this OA prays for promotion to the post of Superintendent of Land Records. He relies on Clause No.12-A and 12-C of G.R. dated 15.12.2017. He further submits that the Applicant is exonerated in appeal from DE on 07.07.2023. On 11.09.2023, the Respondents issued communication to all the eligible Government servants of Feeder Cadre of Deputy Superintendent of Land Records to submit their options. However, Applicant's name does not figure in the said list. Therefore, he prays that as the Applicant is exonerated on 07.07.2023, his sealed cover be opened. He was held guilty and punished on 05.03.2023. So his name was kept in sealed cover and subsequently, by order dated 07.07.2023, he is exonerated by the Appellate Authority and hence, at this stage, sealed cover is required to be opened and the name of the Applicant is considered. On 13th September, 2023, the Applicant has approached this Tribunal.</p> <p>4. The Ld. C.P.O submits that the meeting of the D.P.O for the present promotion was conducted on 17.1.2023 and at the relevant time the applicant was not exonerated. His name was considered for the first time on 13.1.2021 for the select list of 2020-21 for promotion and his case was kept in 'sealed cover' and that 'sealed cover' is required to be opened. The applicant was exonerated of the charges on 7.7.2023. The proposal for promotion of the applicant on account of his exoneration was received from the Office of the Settlement Commissioner on 25.7.2023. Learned C.P.O on instructions from Mr. Sanjay Banker, Joint Secretary, Revenue &amp; Forest Department, submits that the process of file regarding opening of the 'sealed cover' has been submitted to the</p>

Learned P.O. has also submitted the copy of the 'Office Order' of the office of Commissioner of Police, Mumbai dated 04.10.2023 which contains names of all the 68 Male Constables and 62 Female Constables. The officer present on behalf of the 'Commissioner of Police, Mumbai' on query has informed through learned P.O. that the 68 Male Constables and 62 Female Constables have been relieved on 04.10.2023 to join the establishments of other (i) Commissioners of Police and (ii) Superintendent of Police based on confirmed reports received about number of 'Vacant Posts' of Police Constables on the establishments of other (i) Commissioners of Police and (ii) Superintendents of Police. However, further on query, the officer informed through P.O. that establishments of the (a) Commissioner of Police, (i) Nashik City &amp; (ii) Pimpri-Chinchwad &amp; (b) Superintendents of Police, (i) Satara &amp; (ii) Ahmednagar had not confirmed the number of 'Vacant Posts' of Police Constables before the meeting of 04.10.2023 held by Commissioner of Police, Mumbai. 6. We have considered the submissions, prayers and also the issue involved therein. The prayer for promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Central Prison/Superintendent of District Prison, Class-II is redressed and the other prayer that his name is to be dropped from DE has become infructuous because the DE is already completed by order dated 2.2.2022. The third prayer that he is to provided benefit of functional promotion cannot be entertained as he has not fulfilled the condition of requisite experience of 3 years. Considering this factual position the judgment and order dated 3.2.2022 passed by the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal in OA No.352/2021 Krishna G. Jadhav Vs. The State of Maharashtra & Ors. cannot be considered.

7. Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that he has made representation for deemed date and he will file separate OA for deemed date and also for promotion.

8. In view of this, we dispose of the OA. However, we direct the respondents to consider and decide the representation of the applicant for deemed date if at all pending before the department at the earliest.
