His options were called and accordingly he gave options in terms of circular dated 11.07.2000 and G.R. dated 06.08.2002 which inter-alia states that the Government servant who has worked in tribal area is entitled to claim choice posting completion of 2 years service in tribal area. Whereas, in present case the Applicant admittedly worked in tribal area for 3 years and due for General Transfer in 2021. He therefore gave options but it was not considered and she was given posting as C.D.P.O. (Rural) Akkalkuva, District-Nandurbar.
- 3. Learned P.O. sought to contend that the post of Akkalkuva also falls in tribal area and from the point of administrative exigencies the said post was required to be filled in.
- 4. Undisputedly, in terms of G.R. dated 06.08.2002 a employee who has worked in tribal area for 2 years is entitled to choice posting. Accordingly, the Applicant has given options but his options were totally discarded.

again made representation on Thereafter, she 09.08.2021 asking for some other place of choice in addition to options given by him at the time of general transfer. However, Government in defiance of its own G.R. dated 06.08.2002 declined choice posting to the Applicant. No such compelling reasons forthcoming to deviate from G.R. dated 06.08.2002 to deprive the Applicant from getting posting as per choice in terms of Needles to mention once G.R. dated 06.08.2002. Government has taken policy decision to give benefits of choice posting to a Government servant who worked in tribal area sacrificing his or her comfort then Government should act in pursuance of its own policy in fair and transparent manner.

- 5. It is on the above background learned Advocate for the Applicant made fair submission that Respondents be directed to consider the representation of the Applicant for getting choice posting in terms of G.R. dated 06.08.2002 in ensuing general transfer of 2022, so that nobody is disturbed. This submission is quite reasonable and fair.
- 6. In view of above, I pass the following order.

Respondent is directed to consider the representation made by the Applicant on 09.08.2021 as well as the option given by the Applicant at the time of general transfer (general transfer 2021 pg 14 of P.B.) and shall take appropriate decision on it in the light of G.R. dated 06.08.2002 and the decision as the case may be shall be communicated to the Applicant.

- 7. Respondents is at liberty to call for additional options from the Applicant at the time of general transfer of 2022 and considering her additional options, shall pass appropriate orders so that there should be wider scope for giving posting to the Applicant as per his choice in terms of G.R. dated 06.08.2002.
