- 3. The office objections, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 4. Issue notice before admission returnable on 01.02.2023.
- 5. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondent intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 6. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 7. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 8. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original / Miscellaneous Applications shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / Miscellaneous Applications shall stand dismissed.

Talekar, learned Counsel for Applicants in respective applications and Ms. S.P. Manchekar, learned CPO. Shri A.B. Moon, learned Counsel in intervention application i.e. M.A. No.12/2023. In O.A. Nos. 300 & 301 of 2022, no one has caused appearance.
- 2. Intervention Application bearing No. 12/2023 be kept pending and it will be decided at the time of disposal of all these OAs.
- 3. When today the present matters are taken up for consideration, the order passed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in Writ Petition Nos. 224 & 226 both of 2023 yesterday i.e. on 5.1.2023 is placed on record. After having gone through the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, it appears to us that there may not be

any impediment for proceeding with hearing of these matters.

- 4. During course \circ f submissions advanced yesterday, it was informed that there are only 54 candidates, who got the benefit of the orders passed by this Tribunal at Principal Seat, as well as, at Benches at Nagpur & Aurangabad. Such information was given by the learned CPO. However, according to shri Dere, learned Counsel appearing for Applicants in some earlier OAs, the number is much more than 54 and according to him, number of such candidates may be around to 250. We are further informed that training of such selected candidates has been commenced at different Centres. There are about 10 Training Centres where the candidates are deputed for training.
- 5. In view of varying information received as about number of candidates, who got the benefit of the orders passed by this Tribunal, we direct the learned CPO to ascertain correct information from the authorities concerned with all necessary particulars and file a short Affidavit in that regard by 12.1.2023. We further direct the learned CPO to ensure that all such candidates are duly noticed as about the hearing of present OAs by the Full Bench on 17th of January, 2023.
- 6. S.O. to 17th January, 2023. It is clarified that the Full Bench will sit on 17.1.2023, as well as, on 18.1.2023.
