- Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicants who are from cadre of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' were posted in 'Functional Departments' by 'Transfer Order' dated 13.01.2024 and 15.01.2024 of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune'.
- Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' was subsequently issued after scrutiny of all earlier 'Transfer Orders' of 'Police Officers' including (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 at level of 'Additional Chief Secretary' and 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' following review meeting held on 20.02.2024. Therefore earlier 'Transfer Orders' of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 have been superseded by new 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.
- Learned Advocate for Applicants thereupon states that the Applicants have consequently been posted out of 'Pune District' by 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' on grounds they were serving in their 'Home District'. However, the Applicants had

been recently posted by 'Transfer Order' of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 to posts of 'Functional Departments' which had been lying vacant for long period of time. Applicants have also not replaced any other officers from cadre of 'P.S.I' and 'A.P.I.' who were serving on posts in 'Functional Departments' so as to contravene directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. The posts in 'Functional Departments' where Applicants had been transferred are not those given direct responsibility for 'Security Arrangements' or 'Deployment of Police Forces' during conduct of 'General Elections to Lok Sabha 2024'.

- Learned P.O. along with Law Officer on behalf of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' states that after review meeting held on 20.12.2024 by 'Additional Chief Secretary' and 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' with 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' and 'Senior Police Officers' including (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' instructions were given by 'Additional Chief Secretary' and 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' letter dated 22.02.2024 to stringently implement the directions in 'Election of Commission of India' dated 21.12.2023 read with clarifications dated 19.01.2024 and 24.01.2024 and accordingly earlier 'Transfer Orders' of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 were reviewed by 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'. Thereafter new 'Transfer Orders' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' came to be issued in respect of all 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' who were posted in their 'Home Districts' but were not serving on 'Functional Posts' at the time of coming into effect of directions in 'Election Commissioner of India' letter dated 21.12.2024.
- Learned P.O. along with Law Officer on behalf of clarified Maharashtra State' further 'D.G.P. instructions given to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' by 'Additional Chief Secretary' and 'Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra State' letter dated 22.02.2024 did not distinguish the modus of implementation of directions in 'Election of Commission of India' dated 21.12.2023 read with clarifications dated 19.01.2024 and 24.01.2024 between 'Police Inspectors' and 'P.Ş.İ.' & 'A.P.İ' and after full and comprehensive review of all earlier transfers of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' serving in 'Home District' the new 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' was issued for implementation in both letter and

spirit of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.

7. Learned P.O. and 'Law Officer' on behalf 'Maharashtra State' therefore emphasized that on their own they cannot now seek any review of 'Transfer Orders' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' in respect of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I' only on the ground that although Applicants were serving in 'Home District' on posts in 'Functional Departments' they had not replaced other officers who were earlier working on such posts 'Functional Departments' as on 21.12.2023 but had been posted only on 'Vacant Posts' unlike as it was in cases of 'Police Inspectors' who were similarly serving in their 'Home Districts' in establishments of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune'.

The 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' had held 'Virtual Conference' on 10.01.2024 with 'Heads of Police Establishments' on the basis of which earlier 'Transfer Orders' were issued by (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Pplice, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 in respect of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' including Applicants to post them to 'Vacant Posts' 'Functional Departments'. The 'Transfer Orders' of (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' dated 1\(\beta \).01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 may have been issued for certain good reasons such as concern about the fact that these 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I' had not completed their 'Normal Tenures' under 'Section 22N' of the 'Maharashtra Police Act, 1951' and as many posts of 'Functional Departments' had been lying vacant for long time etc. and thence such 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' would not come within purview of directions in 'Election' Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. However, the fact now is that these considerations no longer hold justiciable grounds after issue of new 'Transfer Order' dated 26.02.2024 of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' in respect of all 'P.S.I' and 'A.P.I.' who were serving in their 'Home district' as on 21.12.2023 but on posts not in 'Functional Departments.

Tribunal's orders

The directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023 in 'Para 5.3(ii)' give special consideration to 'P.S.I.' only in respect of criteria of completion of tenures of '3 years' in last '4 years' 'interalia' permitting them to be shifted out to 'Police Sub Division' which do not fall in same Assembly Constituency (AC). However, no such special consideration is given to 'P.S.I.' with regard to criteria of 'Home District'. In 'Para 5.3(i)' it is affirmatively mentioned that, 'The Police Sub Inspectors' and above should not be posted in 'Home District'. The 'Criteria' mentioned in 'Para 3(i)' and 'Para 3(ii)' and 'Applicability' elaborated in 'Para 5.3 (i)' and 'Para 5.3 (ii)' have to be read in conjunction while undertaking stringent implementation of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. Hence, in the facts and circumstances of the case it would be best of leave it to 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' to assess if it would be still necessary for better 'Police Administration' to make any exception in respect of these 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I' who were brought in later on 'Vacant Posts' in 'Functional Departments' by 'Transfer Order' (i) 'Commissioner of Police, Pimpri-Chinchwad' 13.01.2024 and (ii) 'Commissioner of Police, Pune' dated 15.01.2024 much after issue of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023. Infact such 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' could have continued to serve in 'Pune District' inspite of it being their 'Home District' if only 'Transfer Orders' to such 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' to 'Vacant Post' in 'Functional Department' had been issued prior to coming into effect of directions in 'Election Commission of India' letter dated 21.12.2023.

10. The issue of transfer of 'P.S.I.' and 'A.P.I.' from their 'Home Districts' as mentioned above relate to aspects of 'Police Administration'. Hence, it is for 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State' to decide about appropriate course of action if so deemed necessary and accordingly inform in due course through learned P.O. and Law Officer in office of 'D.G.P. Maharashtra State'.

- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant has immediately obeyed the Order dated 30.01.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State'. However he has been posted at long distance from 'Solapur District' and seeks to be posted on any establishment nearby such as of (i)'Commissioner of Police, Kolhapur', (ii)'Commissioner Police, Navi Mumbai', (iii)'Commissioner of Police, Pune', (iv)'Special IGP, Chatrapati Sambhaji Nagar Range', or (v)'Special IGP, Nashik Range.
- Learned Advocate for Applicant further states after Orders dated 30.01.2024 of 'DGP, Maharashtra State' the request in respect of few other 'API' by name (i)Shri. Nanasaheb Balu Sawant, and

(ii)Shri. Satyawan Ramdas Bhuyar, have been considered by 'DGP, Maharashtra State'. - 1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for Respondents.
- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant who is from cadre of 'Executive Engineer, P.W.D.' was posted as 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur' by Order dated 29.09.2022 of 'P.W.D.' and joined there on 06.10.2022.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that subsequently 'Commissioner Cum Director, Municipal Administration, Mumbai' by Order dated 24.01.2023 had given to Applicant certain 'Additional Responsibilities' relating to work in 'Satara, Sangli and Kolhapur Districts' while permitting him to work on post of 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur'.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that recently 'Commissioner Cum Director, Municipal Administration, Mumbai' by letter dated 31.01.2024 to 'Additional Chief Secretary P.W.D.' has communicated that Applicant has been relieved from post of 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur' w.e.f. 31.01.2024.
- 5. The Applicant had been transferred as 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur' by 'P.W.D.' Order dated 29.09.2022. The Applicant had been transferred on 'Deputation Post' of Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur' by 'Competent Authority of P.W.D.'. Hence, his repatriation from this 'Deputation Post' could have been be done only by 'Competent Authority' of 'P.W.D.'
- 6. The 'Commissioner Cum Director, Municipal Administration Directorate, Mumbai' should not have exercised 'Statutory Powers' which not vested with him but are in domain of the 'Competent Authority' of 'P.W.D.' The 'Competent Authority' of 'P.W.D.' who is empowered to make appointments to 'Deputation Post' could have

recalled back the Applicant on grounds of 'Administrative Exigencies' or 'Public Interest'.

- The procedural guidelines of 'G.A.D. G.R. dated 7. 17.12.2016' about recall of Applicant from 'Deputation Post' of 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur' have also been complied with by P.W.D. which is the 'Cadre Controlling Authority'. Hence, in the fact**s** and circumstances of the case: 'P.W.D.' as 'Cadre Controlling Authority' should decide within 'One Week' about validation or otherwise of action taken & reported by 'Commissioner Cum Director, Municipal Administration Directorate, Mumbai' letter 31.01.2024. Otherwise the Applicant would stand permitted by way of 'Interim Relief' to join back on post of 'Executive Engineer, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Municipal Corporation Solapur'.

- 1. Heard Smt. Punam Mahajan, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.
- 2. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant who belongs to cadre of Tahsildar, was by Order dated 07.02.2023 of Revenue & Forest Department transferred to 'Deputation Post' of 'Competent Authotity-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai'. The Applicant had joined on this post on 28.02.2023.
- 3. Learned Advocate for Applicant states that by Order dated 15.02.2024 of Revenue & Forest Department; the 'Respondent No.4' was transferred on 'Deputation Post' of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai' which was held by Applicant.
- 4. Learned Advocate for Applicant then states that by Order dated 01.03.2024 of Housing Department the 'Respondent No.4' was accordingly transferred laterally to join on vacant post of 'Competent Authority-9', in 'SRA, Mumbai'.
- 5. Learned Advocate for Applicant submits that Applicant had completed only about 'One Year' on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai'. The post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai' is notified as that of 'Assistant Electoral Registration Officer' for '172,- Anushakti Nagar LAC'.
- 6. Learned Advocate for Applicant further states that Applicant has submitted Application dated 05.03.2024 to 'Additional Chief Secretary Housing Department', requesting to stay the Order dated 04.03.2023 of Housing Department by which he has

been transferred laterally to post of 'Competent Authority-9 in 'SRA, Mumbai'.

- 7. Learned PO seeks sometime to obtain 'Additional Information' from (i)'Revenue & Forest Department' and (ii)'Housing Department'.
- 8. The Housing Department has issued two consecutive Orders on 01.03.2024 and 04.03.2024 about lateral transfer of 'Respondent No.4' within 'SRA Mumbai'.
- The Revenue & Forest Department before 9. issuing Order dated 15.02.2024 should have consulted Housing Department to ascertain the status of post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai', Nonetheless the Housing Department had acknowledged later the fact that Applicant was serving on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai' and therefore issued Order dated 01.03.2024 to transfer 'Respondent No.4' laterally to vacant post of 'Competent Authority-9' in 'SRA, Mumbai'. However for no plausible reason 'Housing Department' again passed Order dated 04.03.2024 to laterally transfer back 'Respondent No.4' to post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai' and Applicant to vacant post of 'Competent Authority-9' in 'SRA, Mumbai'.
- 10. The flip-flop action on part of Housing Department needs to be explained. Thus in the meanwhile if 'Respondent No.4' has joined on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai': as per Revenue & Forest Department Order dated 15.02.2024 then, in the interim period she be directed to work on vacant post of 'Competent Authority-9' in 'SRA, Mumbai' and Applicant is permitted to continue to work on post of 'Competent Authority-1' in 'SRA, Mumbai'.
