- 2. The Applicant has filed this O.A. for direction to the Respondent Nos.1 to 4 to withhold the retiral benefits of Respondent No.5 (Applicant's husband) till the decision of R.C.S.No.546/2016 pending before the Civil Judge Junior Division, Madha, Dist. Solapur.
- 3. Perusal of record reveals that there is matrimonial dispute between the Applicant Smt Janabai Aagwane and Respondent No.5 since her status as legally wedded wife of Respondent No.5 itself is in dispute. Needless to mention that this relief cannot be entertained by this Tribunal at the instance of Applicant whose marital status itself is in dispute. It is dispute in between husband and wife and it cannot be termed as service dispute to be entertained by the Tribunal. The Applicant has already filed R.C. S. No.546/2016 which is subjudice before the Civil Judge Junior Division, Madha, Dist. Solapur. As such, the Applicant needs to avail legal remedy about her status from Civil Court and the relief claimed by the Applicant in O.A. is not within the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.

- Interesting to note that when the issue of relieving the Applicant by Respondent No.4 was brought to the notice of Respondent No.2 -Director, Accounts & Treasuries, Mumbai, he issued letter dated 31.03.2021 to Respondent No.4 pointing out that action taken by Respondent No.4 is not in consonance with Clause 9 of G.R. dated 08.02.2018 . The Respondent No.2, therefore, specifically asked Respondent No.4 to cancel the impugned order and reinstate the Applicant in his post. Despite this position, Respondent No.4 failed to justify his action by his letter addressed to Respondent No.2 which is indeed in contravention of R.R. dated 08.02.20218.

- 6. Smt. Archana B.K., learned P.O. is now present before the Tribunal and prayed for two days time to file reply on behalf of the Respondent No.2.
- 7. In view of above, apparently the Respondent No.2 has no regard to the orders passed by the Tribunal and trying to play with the orders of Tribunal with impunity, as if, he is above law.
- 8. Disgusting to note that though the Applicant stands retired on 31.07.2019, full and final retirement benefits are not released. Except verification of service book there seems to be no other hurdle for releasing 100% retiral benefits to the Applicant.
- 9. Indeed, as per Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, the process for sanction of pension is required to be initiated before six months before the date of retirement so that the Government servant should get his legitimate retirement dues soon after his retirement. However, in present case, Provisional Pension and Provisional Gratuity is paid. Apart, GIS, GPF and Leave Encashment is also paid but Commutation and final Gratuity with regular pension is not paid. Suffice to say, there is total negligence and laxity on the part of Respondents particularly Respondent Nos.2 and 3.
- 10. Before passing further order, I am inclined to give two days time to learned P.O. to file reply to the show cause notice by Commissioner, State Excise Department on affidavit, explaining why he failed to submit the same today and also to explain why appropriate steps were not taken in the matter of grant of final retirement benefits to the Applicant though he stands retired on 31.07.2019. If the explanation found unsatisfactory, the Tribunal will be constrained to pass further stern appropriate order in the matter.

- In this matter the applicant appeared for Inspector Certified School and Institutions/Organisation and Methods Officer/Lecturer/District Women and Child Development Officer/Superintendent/Statistical Officer, Group B Examination conducted by MPSC. It is contended that applicant and respondent no.3 are selected from OBC category having equal marks. Though applicant is older to respondent no.3 instead of considering him in merit, he was not given appointment. It is also pleaded in the OA that as per order of this Tribunal in OA No.124 of 2014 and earlier GR dated 5.10.2015, age is determining factor if the candidates secure equal marks.
- Ld. PO submits that notice is not yet issued by this Tribunal. However, as it is already served by the applicant, he relies and produces The Maharashtra Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure, 2014. He pointed out Rule 10 regarding the Appointment of Interview Committee and declaration of result. wherein guidelines and the procedure is laid down. He points out sub rule (7) of Rule 10. For the purpose of ready reference said sub rule (7) of Rule 10 is reproduced as follows:
  - While preparing the final recommendation list for deciding the ranking of the candidates securing equal marks, the following criteria shall be made use of in a sequential manner one after the other:-

- 2. The applicant who is working as Sectional Engineer challenges the order dated 29.10.2020 passed by respondent terminating his services as his caste certificate was declared as invalid.
- 3. The applicant states that his caste certificate was declared as invalid by the Caste Scrutiny Committee, Pune by order dated 6.6.1985. The applicant belongs to Halba Tribe. The applicant thereafter challenged the said decision by filing W.P. No.1361 of 1985 and the said petition was ruled in favour of the applicant wherein the Hon'ble High Court observed as under by order dated 19.9.1985:

"Caste Scrutiny Committee held that Halba Koshti is not Halba. The said order is quashed in view of our decision in the case of Milind Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others (Writ Petition No.2944 of 1984 decided on 4/5/6th September, 1985). The petitioner is declared to be belonging to Halba Tribe. His Caste Certificate is held to be valid. Respondent No.4, Principal, Polytechnic College, Nagpur is directed to admit the petitioner as a Scheduled Tribe candidate, if otherwise qualified. Rule made absolute accordingly. No order as to costs."

4. The applicant thereafter entered service on 20.9.1997 and by order dated 29.10.2020 after 13 years of service the respondents informed him that he does not have valid caste certificate as his caste certificate was declared invalid prior to joining of the services. The respondents for this purpose have relied on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil
