- 3. Learned P.O. opposes the application and submits that she wants to file Affidavit-in-Reply.

Tribunal's orders

- 4. Delay of 223 days is not sustainable and more than that if the learned Advocate for the Applicant had reached on the same day, we fail to understand why he did not make the application on same day for restoring the matter. There is no satisfactory explanation in respect of delay. M.A. for restoration of the O.A. should have been filed within 90 days but due to COVID-19 Pandemic it was filed in 2023. But still there is delay.
- 5. We would like to point out that when the O.A. was filed the age of the Applicant was 52 years and as the prayer is made to give him appointment in the selection whereas today his age is 56 years.
- 6. MA seeking condonation of delay is rejected. Since the M.A. is dismissed the Original Application also stands dismissed.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed Original Application No. 1079 of 2019 before the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Mumbai (hereafter "the Tribunal", for short). The same is pending and not yet decided. The learned counsel submits that the pleadings are completed.
 - 2. It is submitted that the original application is fixed for final hearing since the year 2020. The petitioner is seeking appointment.
 - 3. We are not aware of the number of matters pending before the Tribunal. The petitioner may make an application before the Tribunal for expeditious disposal of the original application. The Tribunal certainly would consider the exigency in the matter and may take a decision with regard to the expeditious disposal.
 - 4. With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs."
- 4. We take matters serially of selection/appointment. Hence, S.O. to 12.4.2023

- 1. Heard Shri M. D. Lonkar, learned Counsel for the Applicant and Smt. Archana B. K., learned Presenting Officer for the Respondent No.2 and Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Counsel for Respondent No.1.
- 2. Present O.A. is filed to the extent of challenging the order passed by the Tribunal in O.A.No.63/203 on 28.03.2023 about reinstatement of the Applicant on the post she was holding at the time of suspension within two weeks from the date of order.
- 3. In that O.A, the Applicant Smt. Trupti Kolte challenged the suspension order dated 09.12.2022. The present Applicant seems to have been posted in place of Applicant after her suspension. The Tribunal by order dated 28.03.2023 allowed the O.A. and suspension order dated 09.12.2022 is quashed and set aside with directions to reinstate the Applicant on the post she was holding at the time of suspension.
- 4. Shri Lonkar, learned Counsel for the Applicant sought interim relief inter-alia contending that present Applicant was not made party in O.A.No.63/2023 and now he is affected by the order of Tribunal dated 28.03.2023 since he is likely to be disturbed from the present post in compliance of the order passed by the Tribunal.

- 7. The office objection, if any, are to be removed and court fees to be paid, if not already paid.
- 8. Issue notice before admission returnable on 11.04.2023.

Private service is allowed. Respondents are put to notice that the case may be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
- 10. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
- 11. By Hand delivery, speed post, courier notice to be served and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
- 12. In case notice is not collected within <u>seven</u> days or service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three</u> days before returnable date, the Original/ <u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall be placed on board before the concerned Benches under the caption "<u>for Dismissal</u>" and thereafter on the subsequent date the Original / <u>Miscellaneous</u> Application shall stand dismissed.
