'Omnibus provides for only 14.07.2017 Nomenclature' using the word 'Mentally Retarded' whereas it should have been aligned within provisions of 'Section 2' relating to Government Servants who are 'Care-givers' as also include all "Specified Disability" defined in the Schedule under 'Right of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016; so to provide for protection to such Government Servant from the routine exercise of 'Transfers & Deputations' subject to 'Administrative Constants' especially when implementation of this law has been made the co-responsibility of both Central Government and all State Governments.
- 5. Learned P.O. to therefore inform the Tribunal as to by which time G.A.D. would review the definition of 'Mentaly Retarded' not only in Notification dated 14.07.2021 but thereafter in respect of all GR's & GC's dealing with the subjects of 'Transfer and Deputation' to bring them in alignment with provisions of 'Section 2' and 'Schedule' under 'Right of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016'.
