Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that the Applicant who was working on the post of District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad, Pune was appointed on 'Deputation Post' of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) by Urban Development Department Government Order dated 10.03.2023 on the basis of recommendations received from the Public Health Department by letter dated 02.03.2023 which had been issued with prior approval of the "Competent Authority".
- Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that Public Health Department by Government Order dated 05.09.2023 posted the Applicant to the Vacant Post of Assistant Director, Health Services, (Blindness Control Programme), Mumbai. Learned Advocate for the Applicant sought to emphasize that it was a conscious decision of the Competent Authority of the Public Health Department taken earlier on 02.03.2023 to spare the services of the Applicant for appointment to the Vacant Post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation for such period of time as may be required for a regular Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation to take over subsequent to promotion or for period of Two Years whichever is earlier. She further states that information per available, the Municipal Commissioner, Pune Municipal Corporation has still not appointed any officer after promotion to the Vacant Post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC).

Learned P.O. submits that due procedure has been followed to recall the Applicant from the post of Health Officer of Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) in exercise of the powers vested with the Public Health Department as per Terms & Condition 2(a) of the UDD Order dated 10.03.2023 based on fact that the post of Assistant Director, Health Services, (Blindness Control Programme), Mumbai was a Vacant Post since 11.08.2023 in the Head Office of 'Director of Health Service, Mumbai.
- Department Development The Urban 5. Government Order dated 10.03.2023 reveals that the Applicant was sent on deputation to the Vacant Post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation only after conscious decision taken by the Competent Authority of the Public Health Department on 02.03.2023 to make Applicants services available till an officer was available on promotion to fill the Vacant Post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation and even to allow Applicant to work on the post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal Corporation for period of upto Two Years. The Government Order of the Urban Development Department dated 10.03.2023 also indicates that the decision was to make available Applicant's services on the Deputation Post for upto Two Years subject to provisions of Maharashtra Civil Services (Joining Time, Foreign Service and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal), Rules, 1981. However, the Competent Authority of Public Health Department without recording grounds relating to Public Interest as was expected to be done as per Terms and Conditions No.2(a) of the Urban Development Department Order dated 10.03.2023 decided suddenly to recall the Applicant and issued Transfer Order on 05.09.2023 in order to fill the Vacant Post of Assistant Director, Health Services, (Blindness Control Programme), Mumbai. The same 'Competent Authority' who had earlier taken conscious decision to recommend that the services of the Applicant could be spared for upto Two Years and accordingly allowed the Applicant to join on the Deputation Post of Health Officer, Pune Municipal now without any Corporation on 02.03.2023 whisper of justifiable reasons based on any stated issued Transfer Order on 'Public Interest' has 05.09.2023 not following the procedure under G.A.D.

Pursuant to the order dated 05.10.2023 passed by this Tribunal, Shri Mandar Kulkarni, Tahsildar, Chandwad, District Nashik has filed short Affidavit in Reply on 06.10.2023 in respect of Exbibit 'F' (Page 38) i.e. declaring reservation of Police Patil as per Population Data certified by Gram Panchayat Members based on 'Census 2011' and Local Enquiry. The relevant paras and portion of the said short Affidavit in Reply is as under:-

"I say and submit that the document annexed by the Applicant at page 38 as Exhibit 'F' was prepared on the basis of information gathered by local staff, such as, Village Talathi, Village Gram Sevak and other local citizen of the said village. It was assumed by me that the information given by them was proper and cored and based on the census date. However, the Committee did not take into consideration the census date. I tender my unconditional apology for accepting the report given by the Local Committee without verifying it with the census data and same may be taken on record.

I further say that the village population information at Exhibit 'E', page 36 is correct and as per census report."

3. As per the order dated 25.06.2007 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.4175/2007 and W.P. No.4202/2007, the Home Department G.R. dated 16.10.2008 was issued giving guidelines for providing reservation to different categories for the post of Police Patil which is to be based on Census Data and Percentage of Population of a particular Backward Class.

This reservation is provided considering the 'Population Data' certified by Gram Panchayat Members and also Shri Mandar Kulkarni, Tahsildar, Chandwad, District Nashik on 25.09.2023 i.e. Exhibit 'F' (Page 38). However, the 'Certificate (दाखला) of *Census of 2011' issued by Shri Mandar Kulkarni, Tahsildar, Chandwad, District Nashik on 27.09.2023 Exhibit 'E' Page 36) should have been considered while providing the reservation for Scheduled Caste (SC) for the Vacant Post of 'Police Patil' of village Nimbale, Tehsil Chandwad, District Nashik as per the Affidavit in Reply dated 06.10.2023 and guidelines in Home Department G.R. dated 16.10.2008.
- 5. Hence, we are of the view that reservation provided for Scheduled Caste (SC) in respect of Village Nimbale, Tehsil Chandwad, District Nashik for the Vacant Post of 'Police Patil' is not based on factual data of 'Census 2011' disclosing correct 'Percentage of Population' belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC). In view of above, Advertisement No.01/2023, dated 25.09.2023 issued by the Respondent No.3 is quashed and set aside qua Village Nimbale, Tehsil Chandwad, District Nashik.
- 6. We also came across an interesting fact while comparing contents of Exhibit 'F' (Page 38) which is prepared on 25.09.2023, on the basis of Population from 'Census 2011' and based on 'Local Enquiry' and Exhibit 'E' (Page 36) which is prepared on 27.09.2023 as per population only from 'Census of 2011'. Total Population of Village Nimbale, Tehsil Chandwad, District Nashik remains identical at 1999, however, population of Scheduled Caste (SC) is shown to have doubled from 144 to 288 while that of Scheduled Tribe (ST) is shown doubled from 253 to 506.
