By this order the Criminal Appeal is admitted. No stay is granted.</p> <p>3. The Applicant was prosecuted for the offence of corruption under section 7, 13(1) (d) r/w. 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act and was acquitted by judgment and order dated 20.7.2011 of the Special Judge Sindhudurg at Oros, prays that the order dated 14.11.2014 issued by Respondent no.2 regarding his promotion and treatment of period of suspension be quashed. It is an admitted fact that the applicant was suspended due to the criminal prosecution against him under the Prevention of Corruption Act. However, he is acquitted from all the offences. He was suspended from the service from 07.12.2009 to 10.05.2012. Thereafter he was reinstated in the service.</p> <p>4. At present he is working as Supervisor in Land records at Kudal. At the time of consideration of his promotion his case was not taken into account because the State has filed appeal challenging the order of acquittal in the Special Case no 15 of 2010. By letter dated 14.11.2014, Deputy Director Land record Konkan Division has informed that as the appeal is pending before the Hon'ble High Court we cannot consider his name for the promotion and only after the decision of the appeal his case for promotion can be considered.</p>

It is made clear that if there is a conviction then the Government is justified in not considering the name of the Applicant, as he would be dismissed. However in the case of acquittal unless there is the stay given in appeal to the judgment, the Government servant cannot be denied of his opportunity of being considered for the promotion.</p> <p>7. In view of the above, we allow this application and the respondents are directed to consider the case of the applicant for promotion by applying usual criteria if otherwise he is found fit. Pendency of appeal against the order of acquittal is not impediment for considering the case of the Applicant for promotion, so also to take the decision about the treatment of the period of suspension.</p> <p>8. 


