- 2. This M.A. is filed to condone huge delay of 14 years caused in filing O.A. challenging communication dated 26.08.2008 whereby the claim of the Applicant for compassionate appointment has been rejected.
- 3. The Applicant's father was in Government service and died in harness on 02.06.2000. That time the Applicant was minor. The Applicant's mother made an application on 03.10.2000 for compassionate appointment to her son who was minor that time. He attained majority on 16.10.2004. However, he did not make an application within one year after attaining majority. He made applications belatedly on 19.04.2006 and 11.07.2007. His applications, therefore, rejected by order dated 26.08.2008. Thereafter, Applicant did not avail legal remedy and filed this O.A. on 13.10.2022 along with application for condonation of delay to condone 14 years delay.

- The only ground raised in M.A. is that Applicant was 4. making **rep**resentations to certain politicians departments and, therefore, could not approach the Tribunal earlier. This could hardly be the ground to condone huge delay of 14 years. Once the claim for compassionate appointment is rejected and it has been communicated to the Applicant by order dated 26.08.2008, the Applicant ought to have availed legal remedy within one year. Mere making of representations would not revive the dead and stale cause of action. Except the ground of making representations, no other ground is pleaded to condone such huge delay of 14 years. The contention that financial condition was not good can hardly be considered for 14 years delay. The Applicant ought to have approached District Legal Authority, if he was really in need of financial assistance.
- 5. As such, there is huge, inordinate and unexplained delay of 14 years to file the O.A. for compassionate appointment. That apart, the period of more than 22 years is over from the date of death of deceased Government servant. The claim for compassionate appointment by the heir has to be proximate to the death of deceased Government servant. The fact that Applicant did not avail legal remedy for 14 years also shows that there was no such necessity of compassionate appointment.
- 6. For the aforesaid reasons, I have no hesitation to sum up that there is absolutely no explanation much less satisfactory to condone huge delay of 14 years. There cannot be endless compassion and we are governed by the law of limitation. The applicant obviously negligent and slept over his claim for 14 years.
- 7. In view of above, Misc. Application is accordingly dismissed with no order as to costs.

- 3. Applicant is present. We have confirmed from the learned Advocate Mr. Hande that no relief is sought against Respondent No.5 and if the present O.As are allowed Respondent No.5 is not going to be affected in any manner.
- 4. Learned Advocate Mr. Hande submits that he is not going to be affected if the O.A. is allowed.
- 5. In view of above, amendment is allowed forthwith.
- 6. Learned Advocate Mr. S.S. Dere will now represent only Respondent No.4, Mr. Amrut Shivaji Patil in O.A.No.1115/2018.
