Learned Advocate for Applicant states that Applicant was repeatedly issued letters by 'Chief Officer & Administrator, Municipal Council, Satara' to which she has replied but also sought information, necessary for preparation of 'Annual Budget: 2024-2025' of 'Municipal Council, Satara'.</p>

The Chief Officer, & Administrator Municipal Council, Satara' acted with undue haste and much beyond administrative competence and authority to relieve Applicant from post of 'Accountant (Class 1)', in 'Municipal Council, Satara' as she belongs to cadre of 'Assistant Director' of Maharashtra Finance & Accounts Service (MFAS).</p> <p>7. The 'Chief Officer, & Administrator, Municipal Council, Satara' could not have by any stretch of imagination taken action to relieve Applicant 'ex-parte' by just writing cryptic letter to 'Under Secretary, Finance Department' dated 16.02.2024. The act of 'Chief Officer & Administrator Municipal Council, Satara' 'prima-facie' smacks of prejudice against Applicant.</p> <p>8. Panchal, learned Advocate for Applicant and Ms. S.P. Manchekar, learned CPO for Respondents. 2. Pursuant to our order dated 07.02.2024, we have come across that there is no any satisfactory reason for not sending the Applicant for training for PSI besides only ground that Criminal Case is pending against the Applicant is forthcoming. We do understand that Police Personnel who is sent for training should have good character and conduct and no Criminal Case should be pending against him. However, in the present case, we have come across that Applicant is prosecuted under Sections 309, 389 of Indian Penal Code and under Sections 110 and 117 of 'Maharashtra Police Act 1951' in Crime No.76/2022 in Nate Sagari Police Station at District Ratnagiri. The Applicant misbehaved by shouting and abusing in Police Station and tried to commit suicide by hanging himself. 3. The offence under Section 309 of 'Indian Penal Code 1860' which relates to attempt to suicide is distinguished from other offences under 'Indian Penal Code 1860' because of provisions of 'Section 115' of 'Mental Health Act 2017'. The provisions of 'Section 115' of 'Mental Health Act 2017' states that "<i>Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 309 of the Indian Penal Code any person who attempts to commit suicide shall be presumed, unless proved otherwise, to have severe stress and shall not be tried and punished under the said Code.</i>" 4. After going through the papers, it appears that Applicant had lost his balance of mind at that time when he had attempted to commit suicide. In view of the fact that charges of Sections 309, 389 of Indian Penal Code and

Sections 110 and 117 of 'Maharashtra Police Act 1951' are distinguished by provisions of 'Section 115' of 'Mental Health Act 2017', we are of the Considered view that Applicant should be sent for training for PSI pursuant to order of Hon'ble Bombay High Court in Writ Petition No.13227/2018 dated 25.09.2023 and Home Department GR dated 20.10.2023 where the name of Applicant is included at Serial No.106.




3. The learned PO submits that Clause 7 of GR dated 15.03.2023 is challenged in this OA and Department would like to make specific submissions on this Clause 7.

On this line, learned C.P.O submitted that in the Preliminary Examination for PSI-2022 the present applicants have secured 14.75 marks, 10.25 marks and 4.50 marks out of 100. However, one post was reserved and they were allowed to appear for the Main Examination, by taking benefit of short-listing criteria of 1:3. Out of the 3 candidates, 2 appeared. The Main Examination was of 400 marks and the learned CPO submitted that they have not secured upto 50%, i.e., 200 marks.
