6. Ld. PO submits that the procedure of selection to the post of Assistant Commissioner, Project Officer, Group A is already completed on 8.1.2016 and appointment orders were also issued of selected candidates. Ld. PO submits that thus the OA has become infructuous and therefore at this stage applicant cannot ask for permission to appear for the interview.

7. Under such circumstances the Ld. Advocate for the applicant submits that applicant has filed this OA No.126/2016 on 29.1.2016 and Hon'ble High Court has passed the order on 23.1.2019 directing the authority to take interview of Smt. Galande. Therefore, same criteria be applied in the present case and applicant be allowed to go for interview.

8. We have considered submissions of both the sides and we found substance in the submissions of Ld. PO. It is old matter of selection. Already other persons are selected and appointed. Under such circumstances, the applicant cannot be sent for interview. The respondents have acted at the relevant time in view of the prevalent rules of reservation and hence the prayer for sending her for interview is hereby rejected.

9. MA is dismissed.
