ORDER

1. Heard Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicants and Miss S.P. Manchekar, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the Respondents for some time.
2. Issue notice returnable on 7.6.2018.
3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.
4. Applicants are authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.



6. The service may be done by hand delivery/ speed post/courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicants are directed to file affidavit of compliance and notice.

7. In case notice is not collected within three days and if service report on affidavit is not filed three days before returnable date, OA shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

8. We record applicants' submission that while answering the OA the respondents shall take care that special advertence be done to para numbers 6.26 to 6.33, 6.38 to 6.46, 6.53, 6.65, 6.66, 6.58 & 6.68.

9. Heard at length on the point of interim relief. Parties agree that detailed reasons may not be recorded for workable arrangement, in the interest of justice.


10. Hence, following order:


(a) Let the process of selection consisting of written test/scrutiny/interview etc. as adopted by the appointing authority and preparation of final merit list including candidature of the present applicants proceed and final merit list be prepared and acted upon.

(b) Until the process is completed, applicants shall continue to render the employment on contract basis, on the same terms and conditions of service as before.

11. The respondents are free to file reply within four weeks. Liberty to both the sides to mention in case urgency arises.

12. Steno copy and hamdast is allowed. Ld. CPO is directed to communicate this order to the respondents.
