In the present O.A., the Applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 29.05.2019 whereby he has been transferred from Nasik Road Central Prison to Aurangabad Central Prison. The Applicant contends that he was transferred before completion of his tenure of six years and, therefore, the impugned transfer order for non compliance of provision of Section 4(4)(ii) and 4(5) of the Transfer Act, 2005 is illegal. He, therefore, prayed for interim relief.</p> <p data-bbox="646 1265 1318 1676">3. However, perusal of record reveals that the Applicant was transferred to Nasik Road Central Prison by order dated 16.05.2013. As such, at the time to impugned transfer order dated 29.05.2019, he had completed normal tenure of six years. Indeed, in his application dated 22.02.2019, he admits that he is due for transfer and requested for Malegaon or Nasik. Only because the Applicant was relieved two months later after his transfer order dated 16.05.2013, it can't be said that his transfer is mid-term or mid-tenure.</p> <p data-bbox="646 1707 1286 1743">4. 2. In the present O.A., the Applicant has sought limited relief of direction to Respondent No.1 to decide his appeal dated 04.07.2016 within stipulated period.

3. Perusal of order dated 09.01.2013 reveals that following punishment was imposed:-

Exercising powers under Section 25 of Maharashtra Police Act, later, by order dated 18.10.2014 by way of corrigendum, instead of post of Police Naik it was replaced by the post of Police Constable. Being aggrieved by it, the Applicant had filed appeal on 04.07.2016 which is pending before the Respondent No.1. As the appeal is not decided within reasonable time, the Applicant has approached this Tribunal on the ground that because of pendency of appeal his further chances for promotion are affected.

4. it is really surprising to know that though the period of three years is over, the appeal is not yet decided by the Respondent No.1 which in fact required to be disposed of expeditiously.

4. in view of above, issue show cause notice returnable on 19.06.2019 to Respondent No.1 to explain why the appeal is not yet decided.


